The southern, eastern, central, southeastern, northwestern, and southwestern areas are dry. The northern, western, and southeastern areas have weak water vapor.

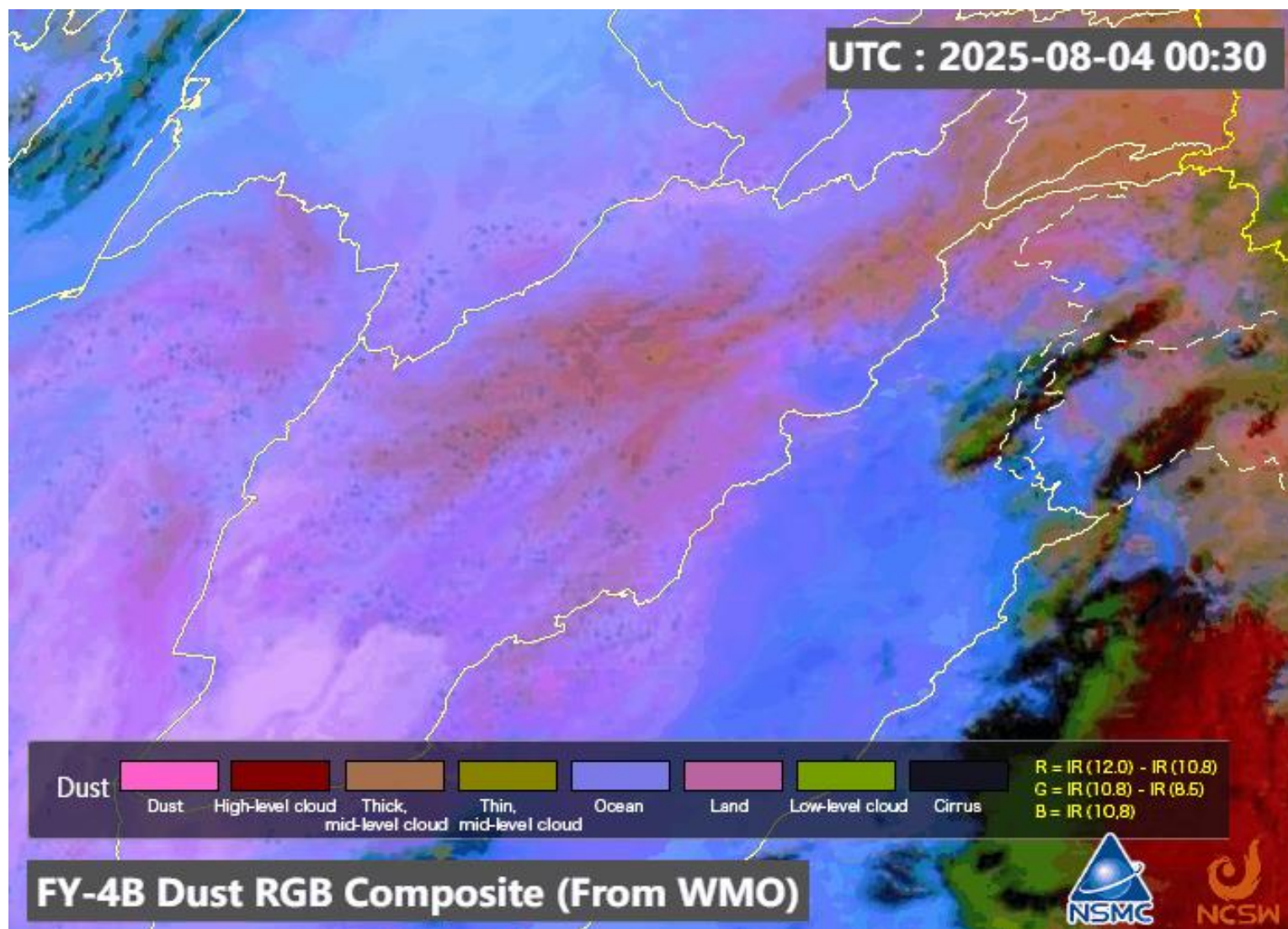

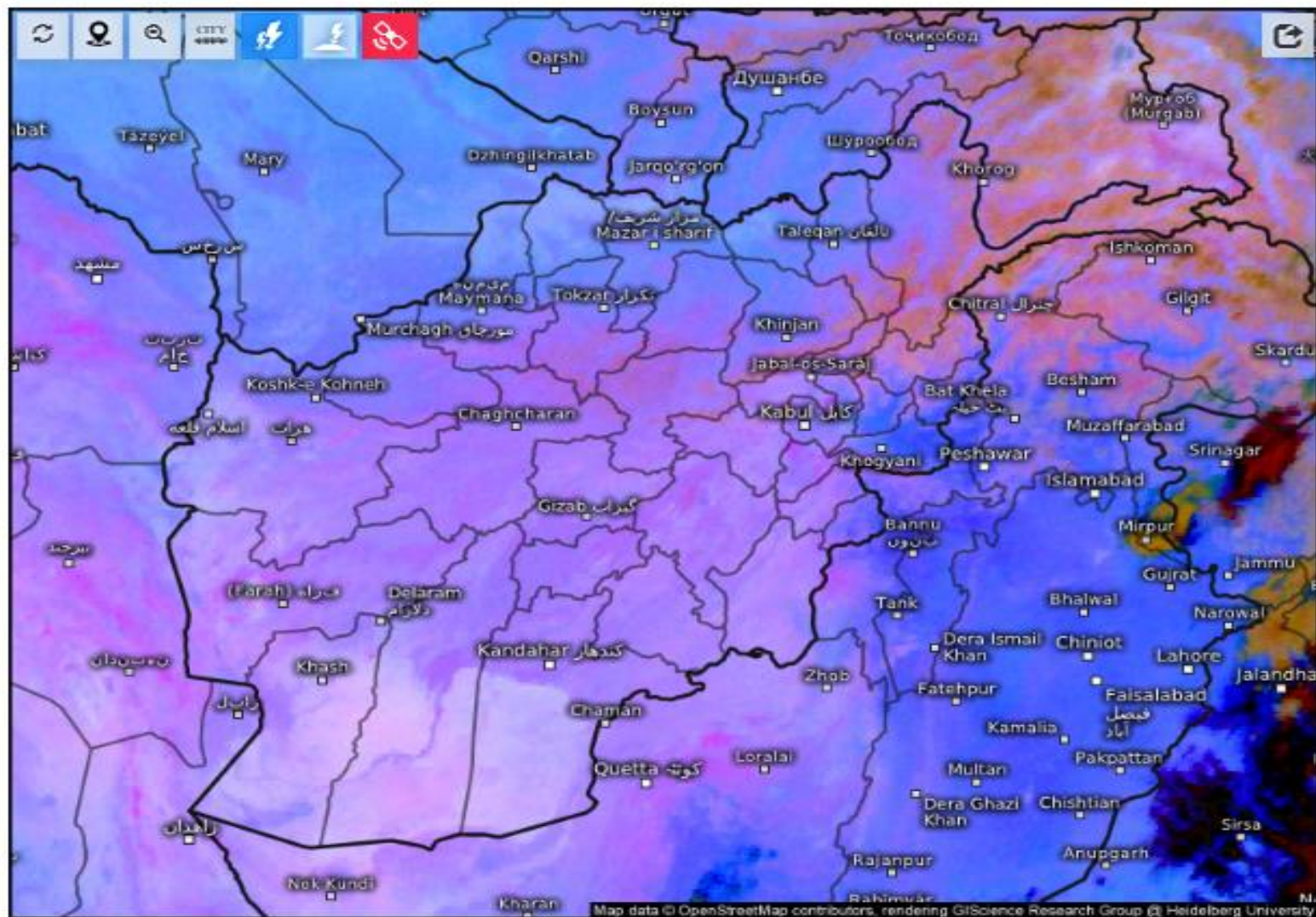


FY-4B AirMass RGB Composite (From WMO)



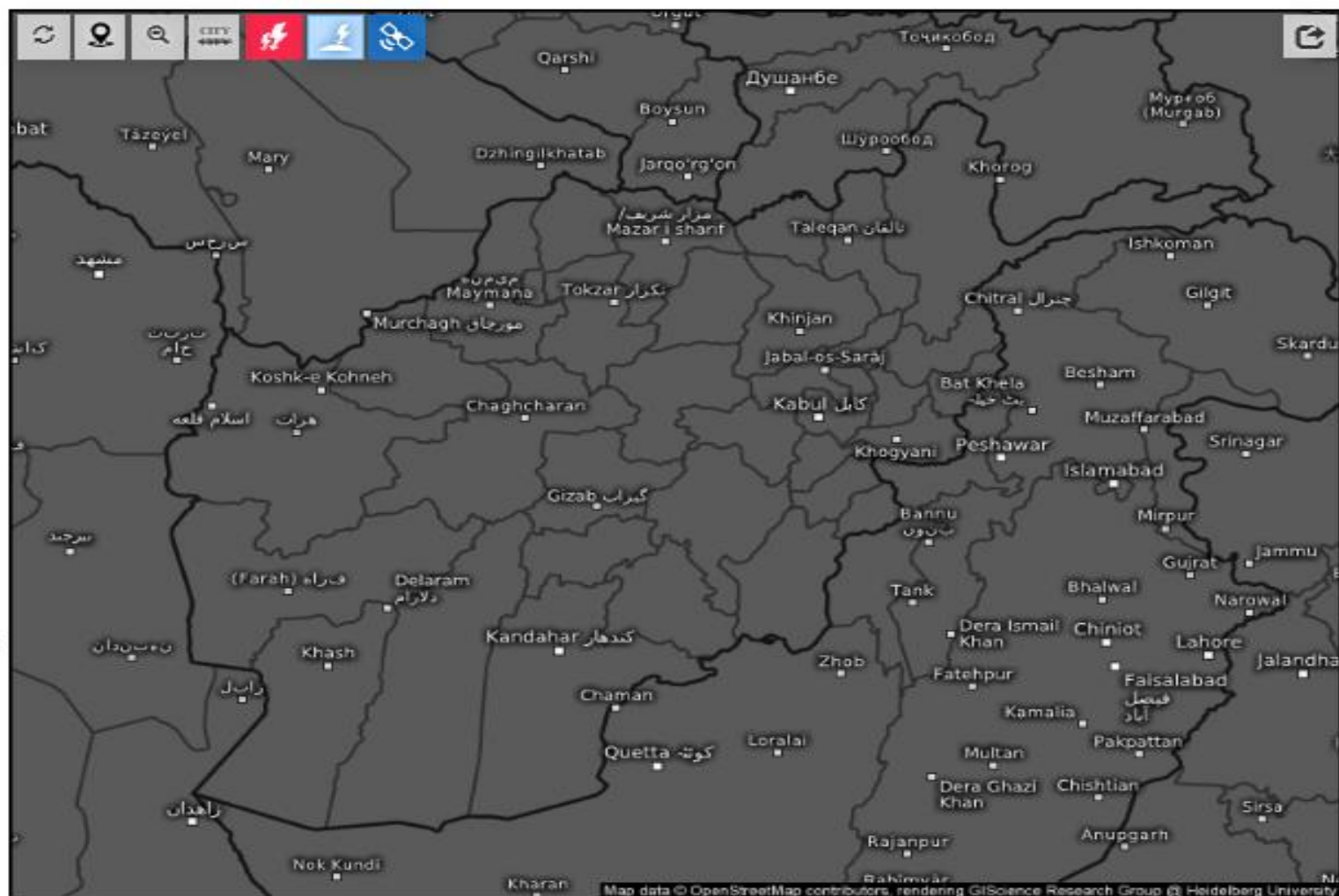

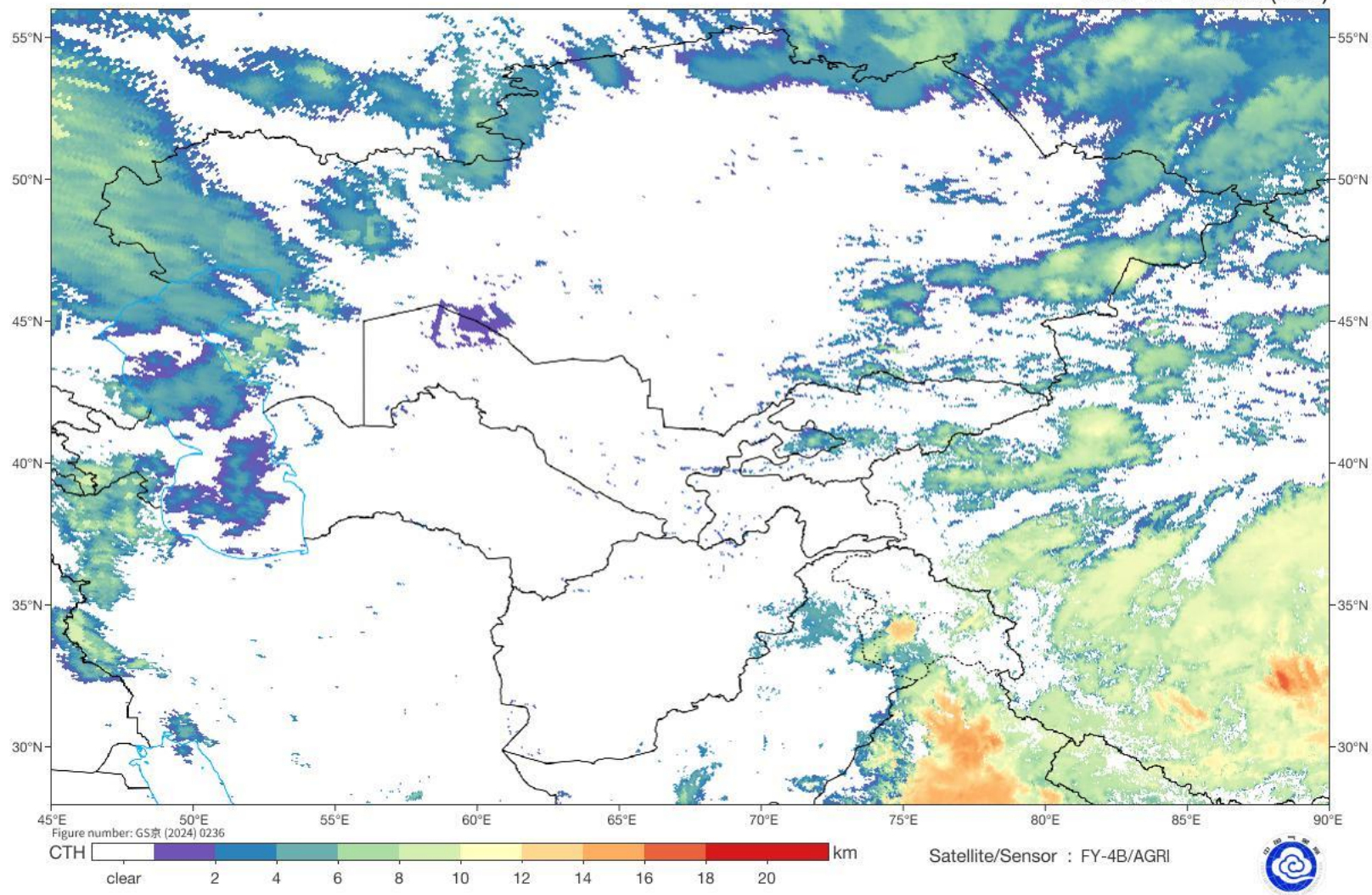


Live satellite map, Afghanistan



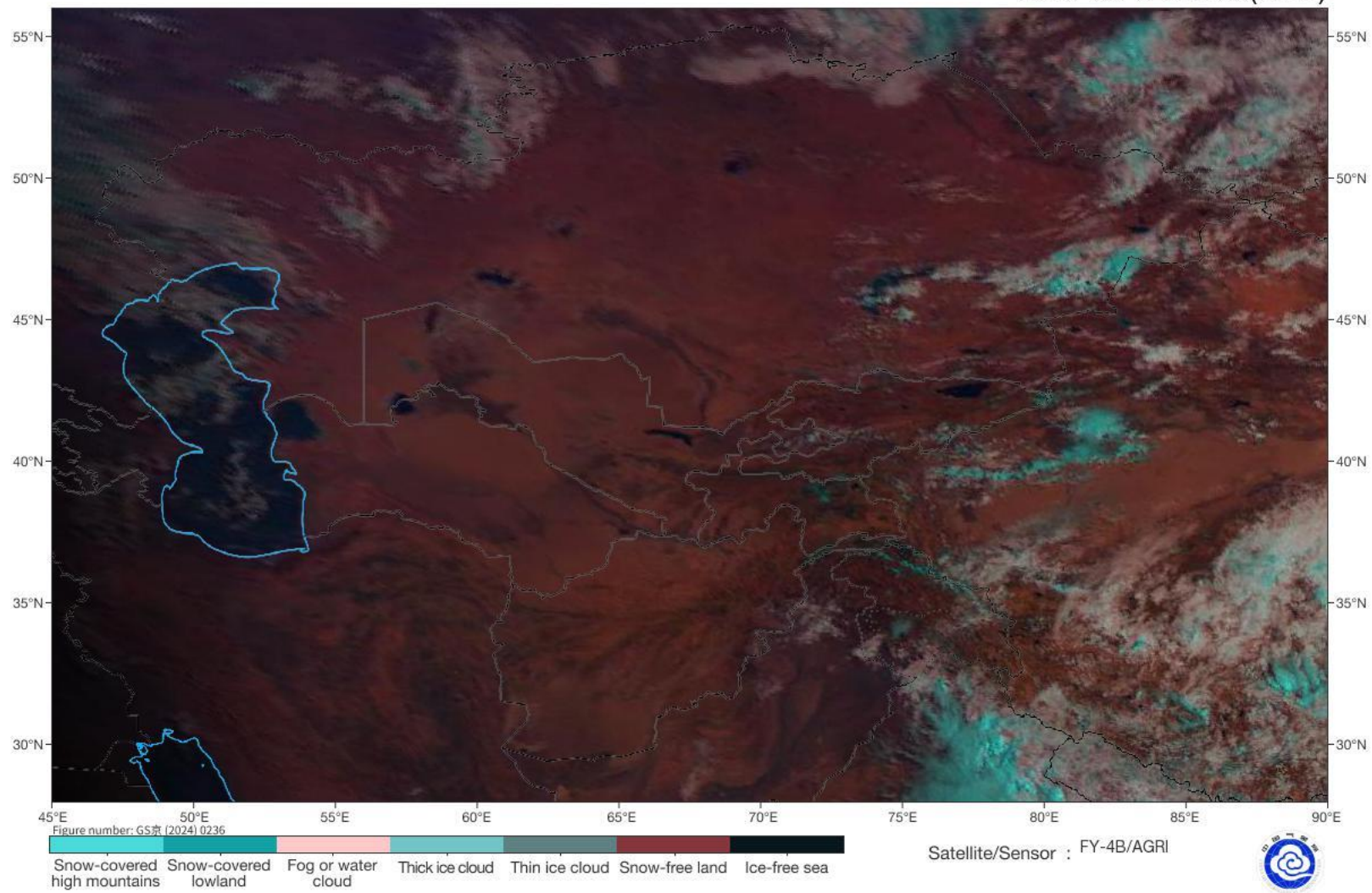
Cloud Top Height

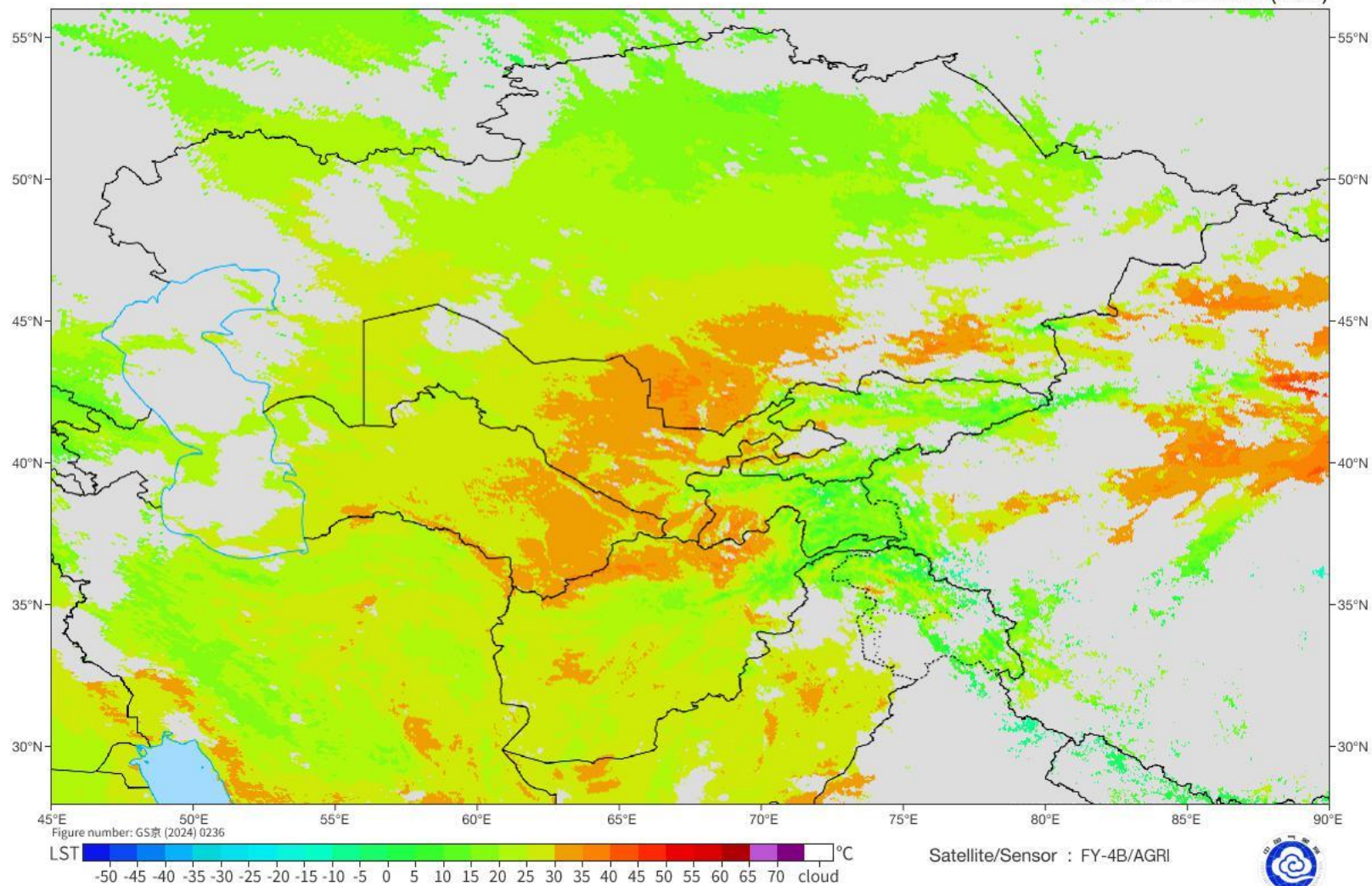
Fog Identification

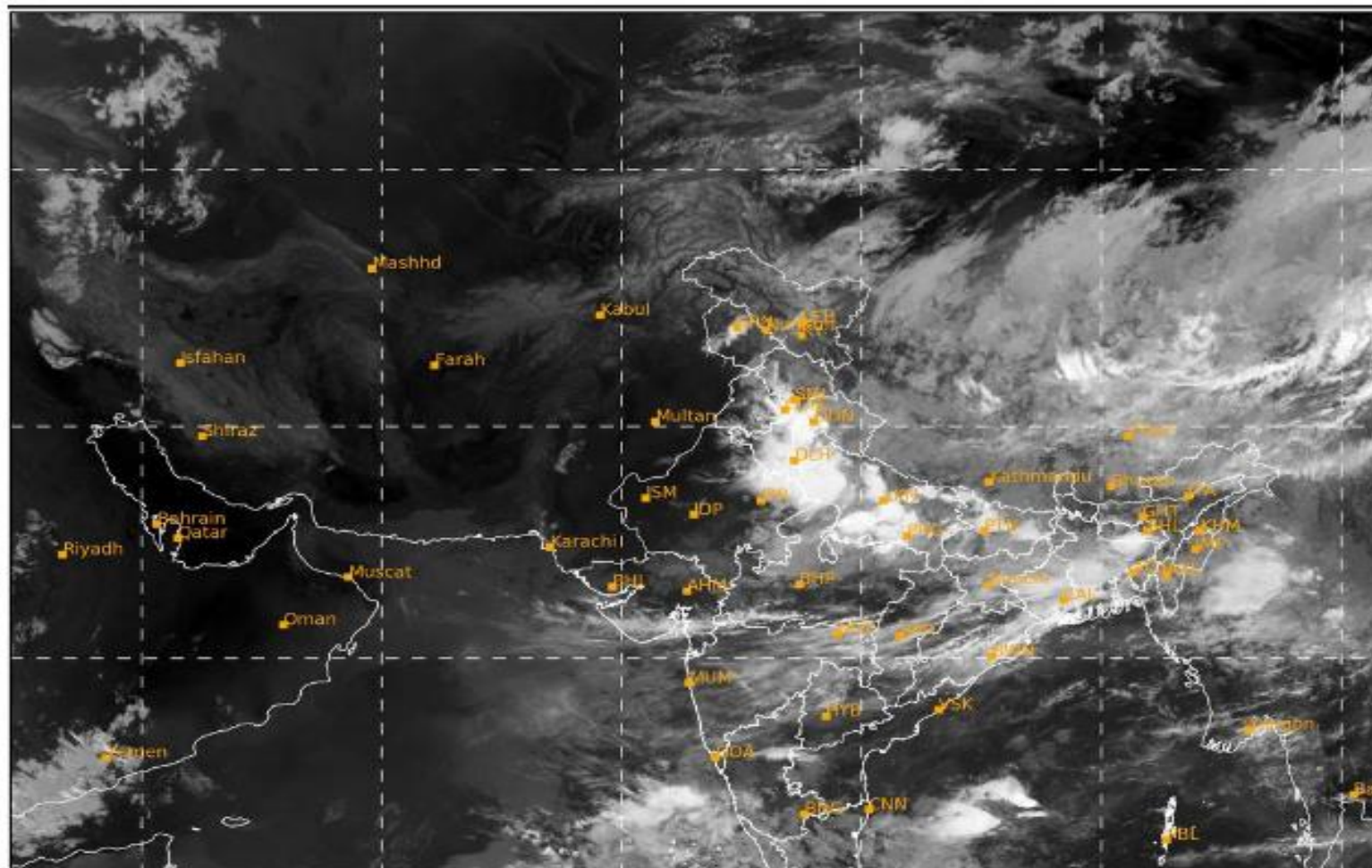
Land Surface Temperature

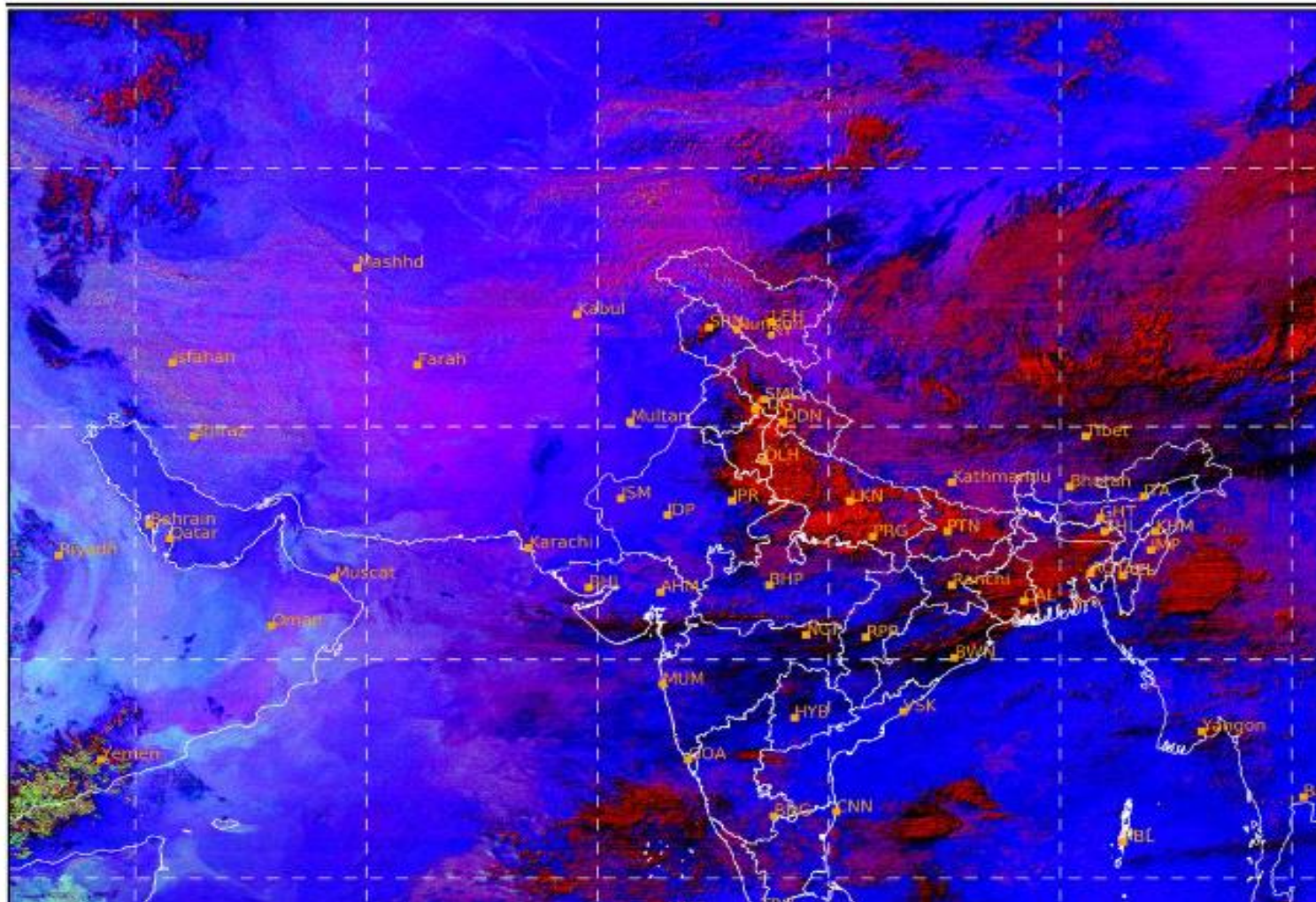

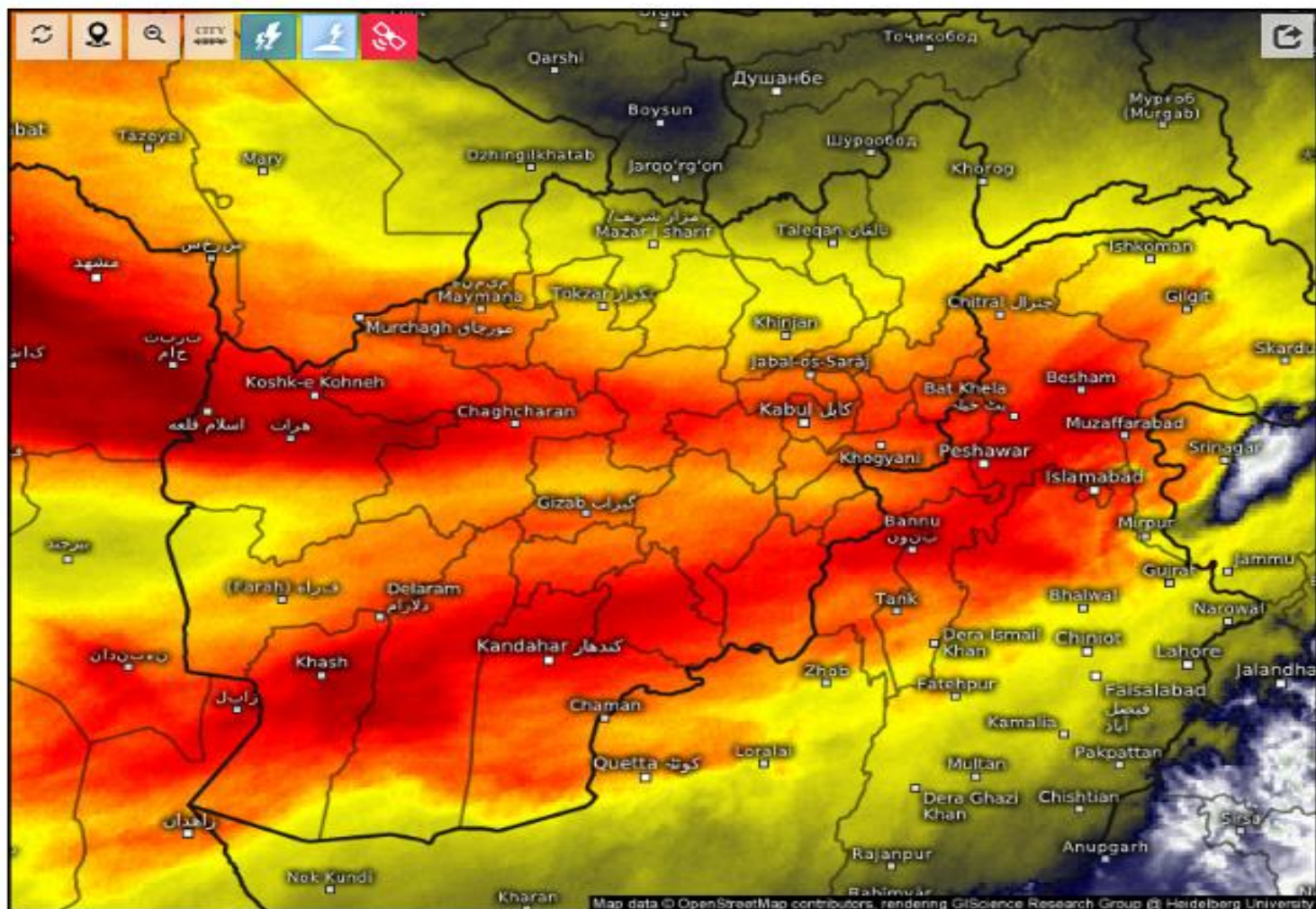

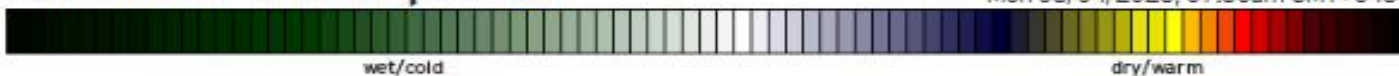
