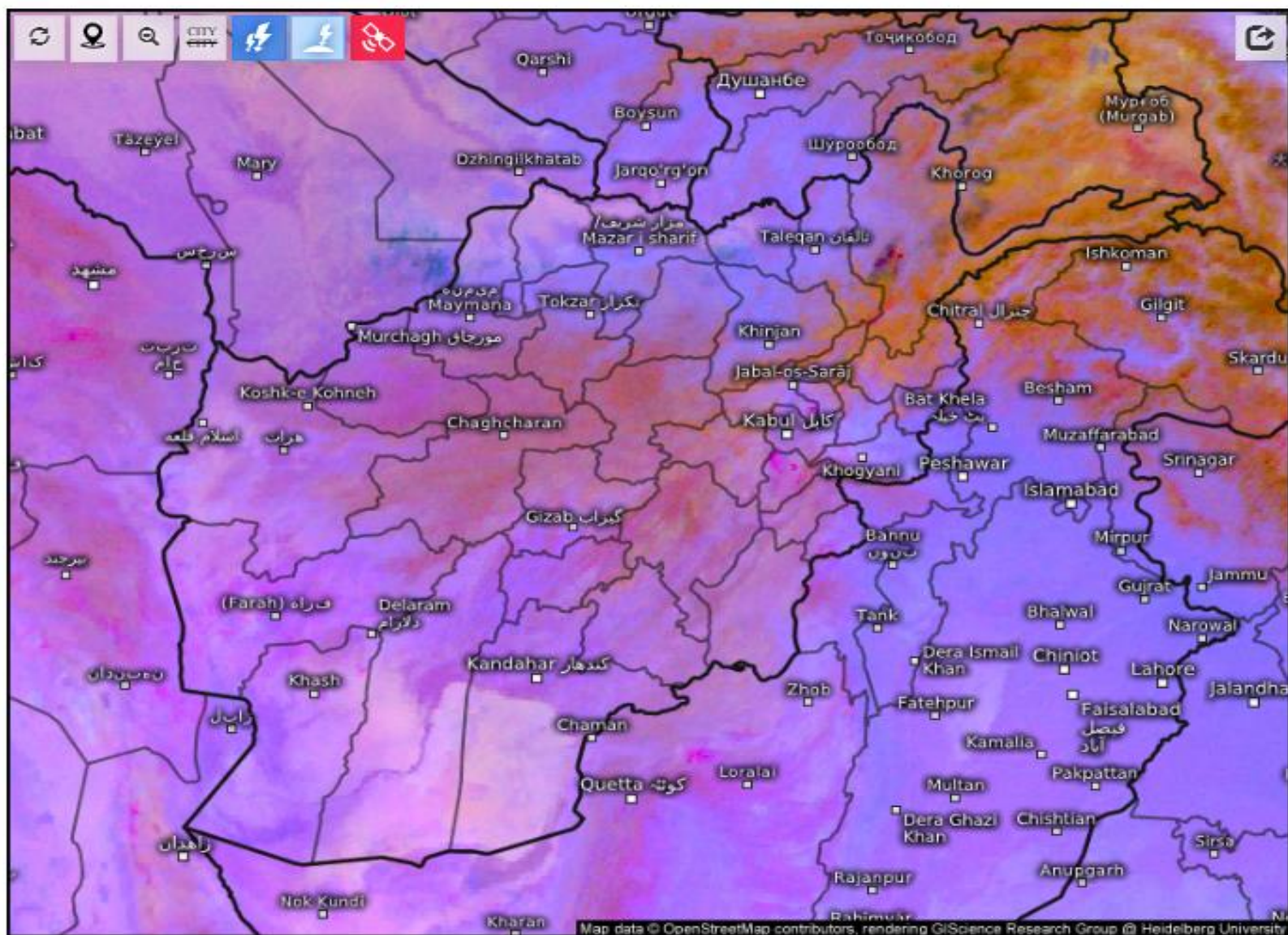

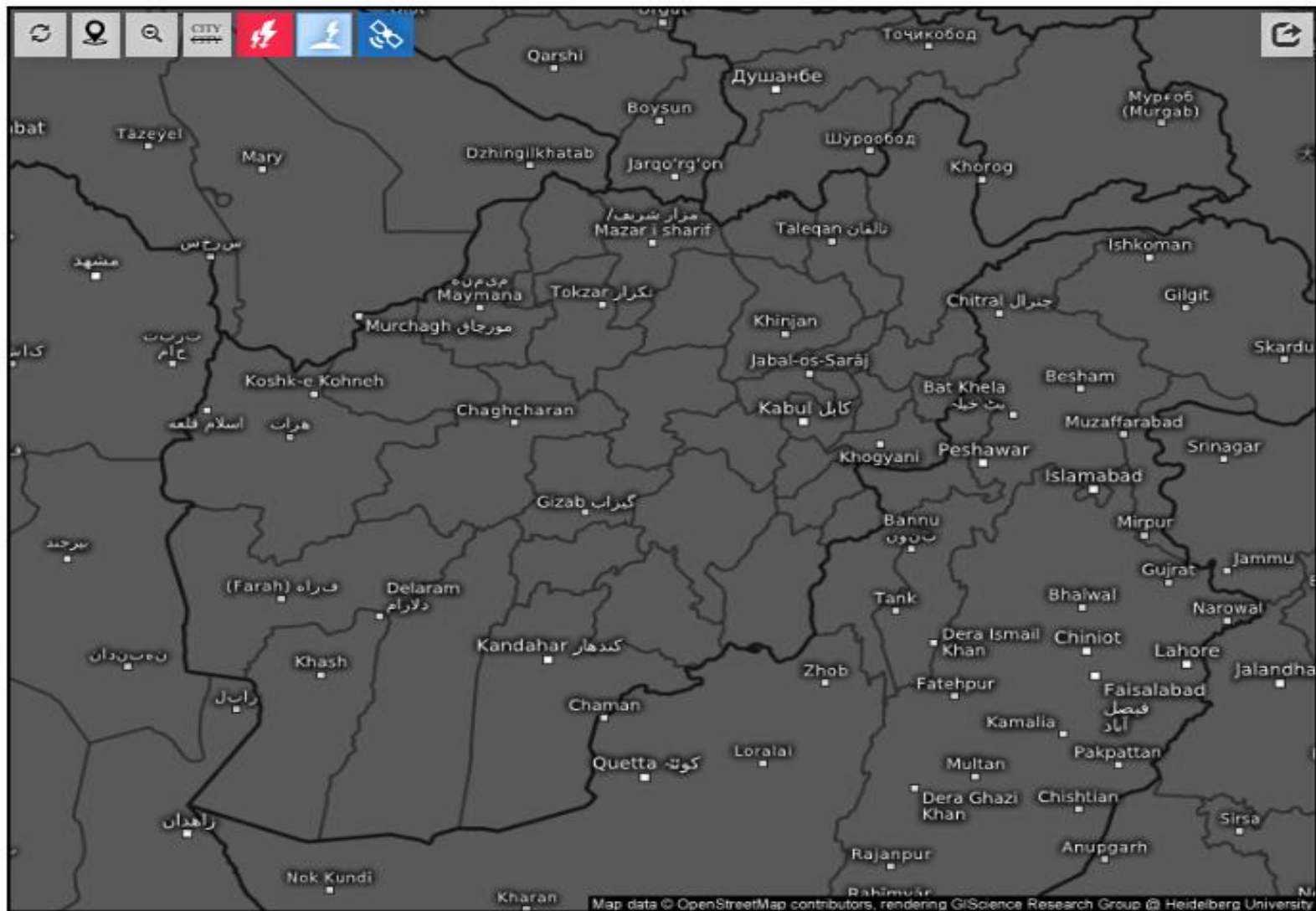
Details: According to satellite imagery analysis, the northern, southern, western, southeastern, northwestern, and southwestern areas have dust storm.

Age of lightning (minutes) 

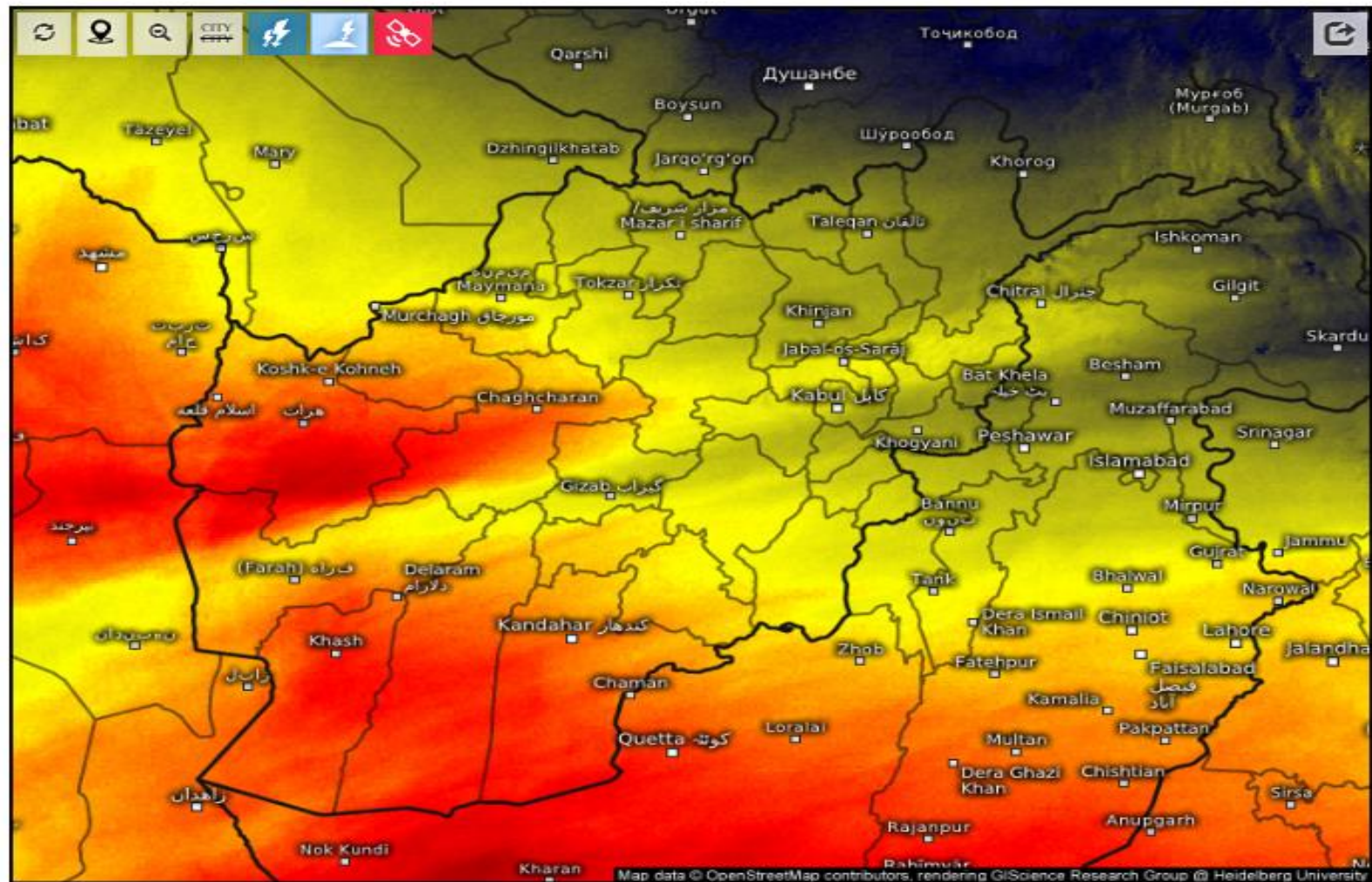
