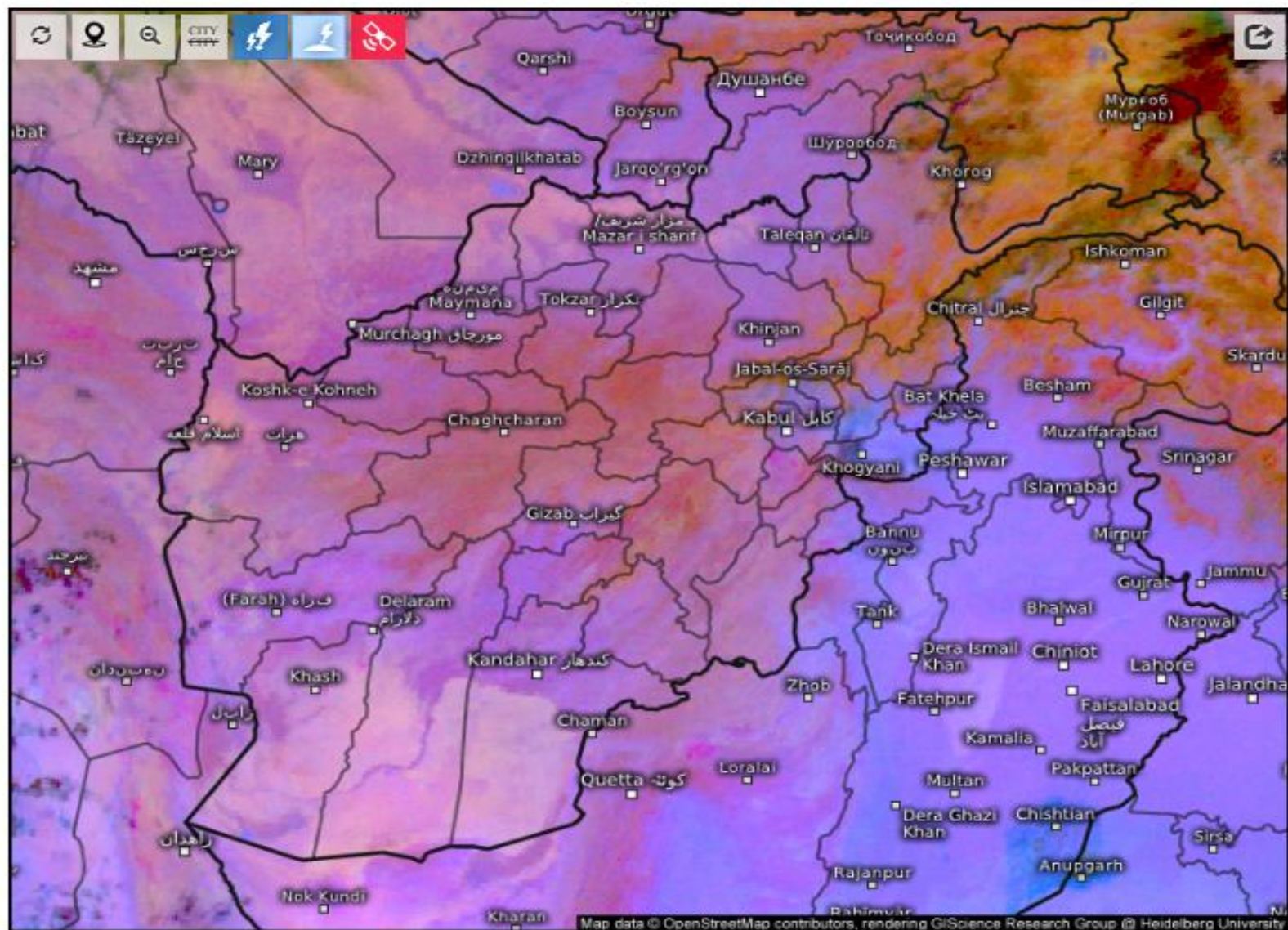

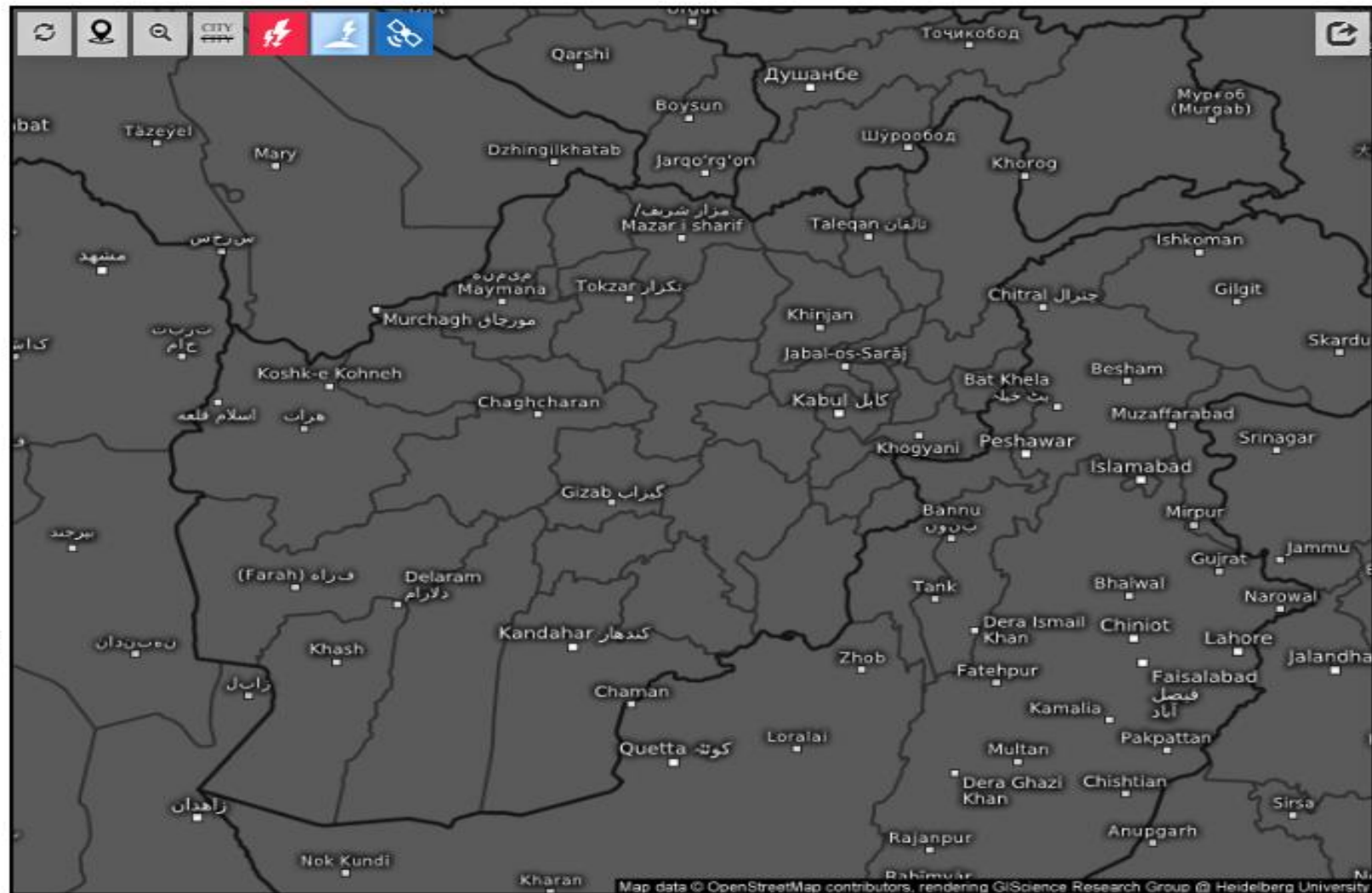

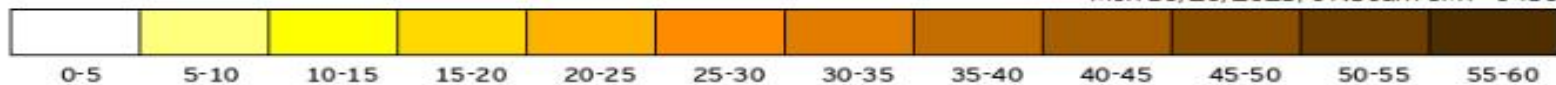

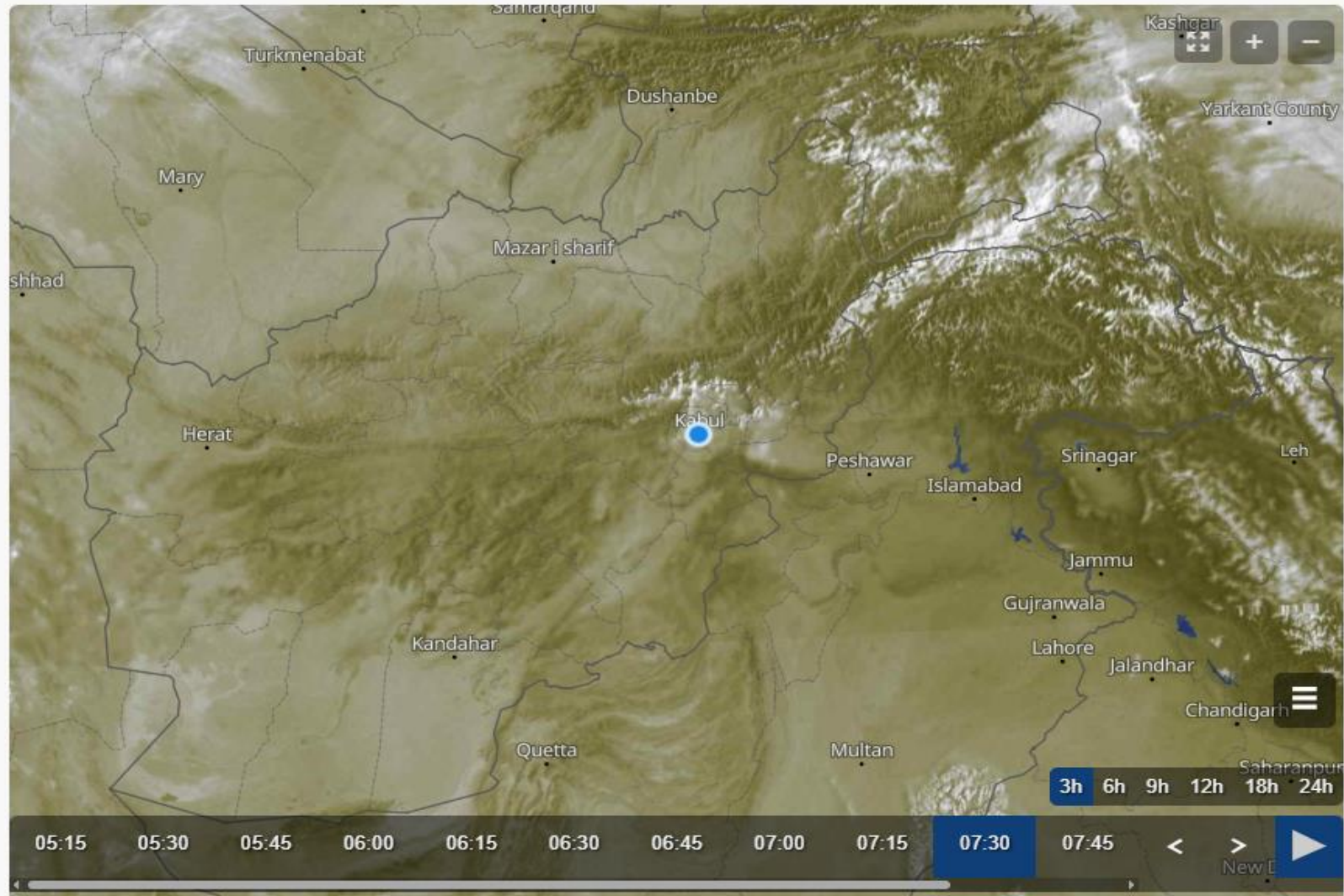


Age of lightning (minutes) 

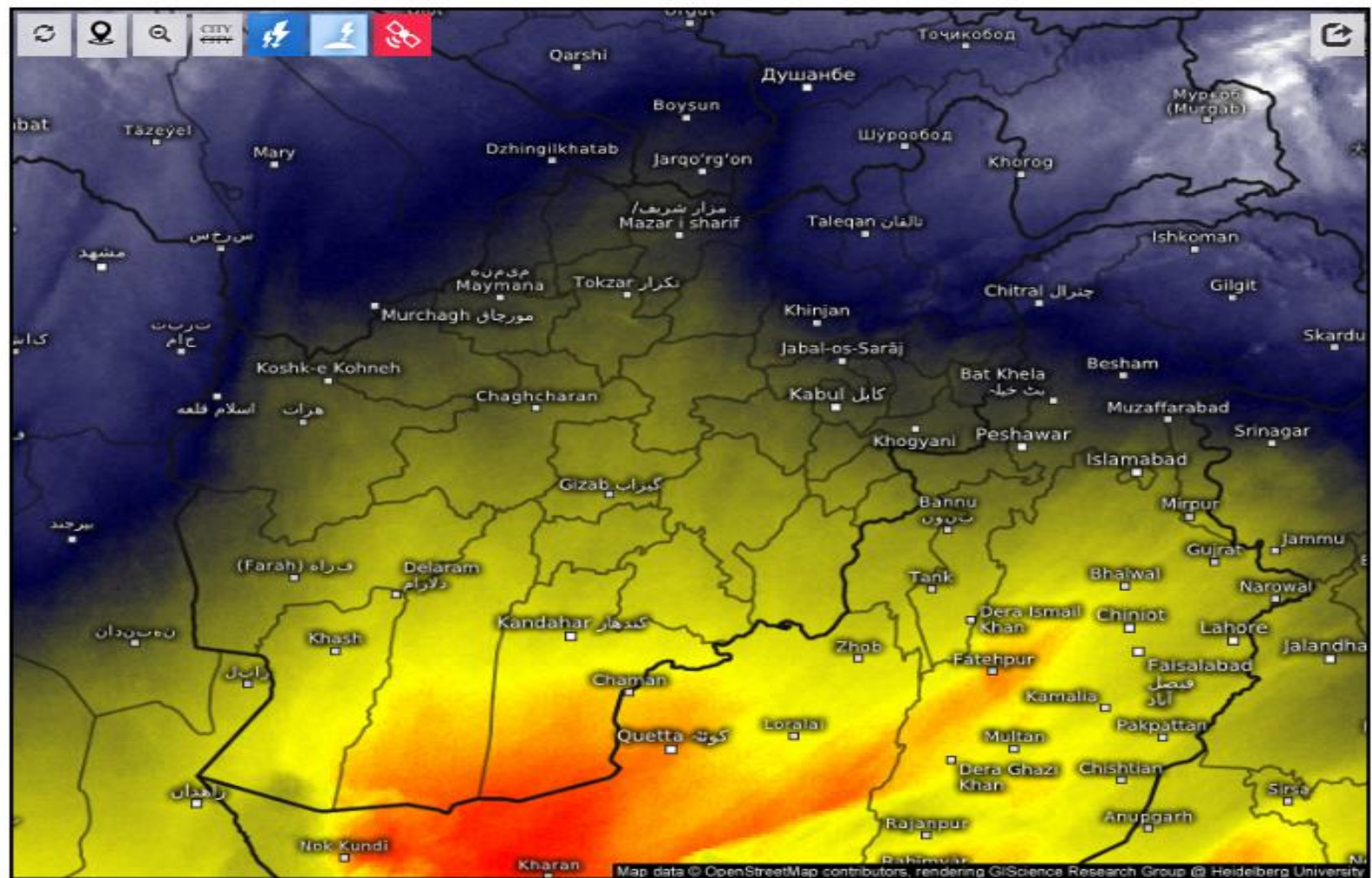
