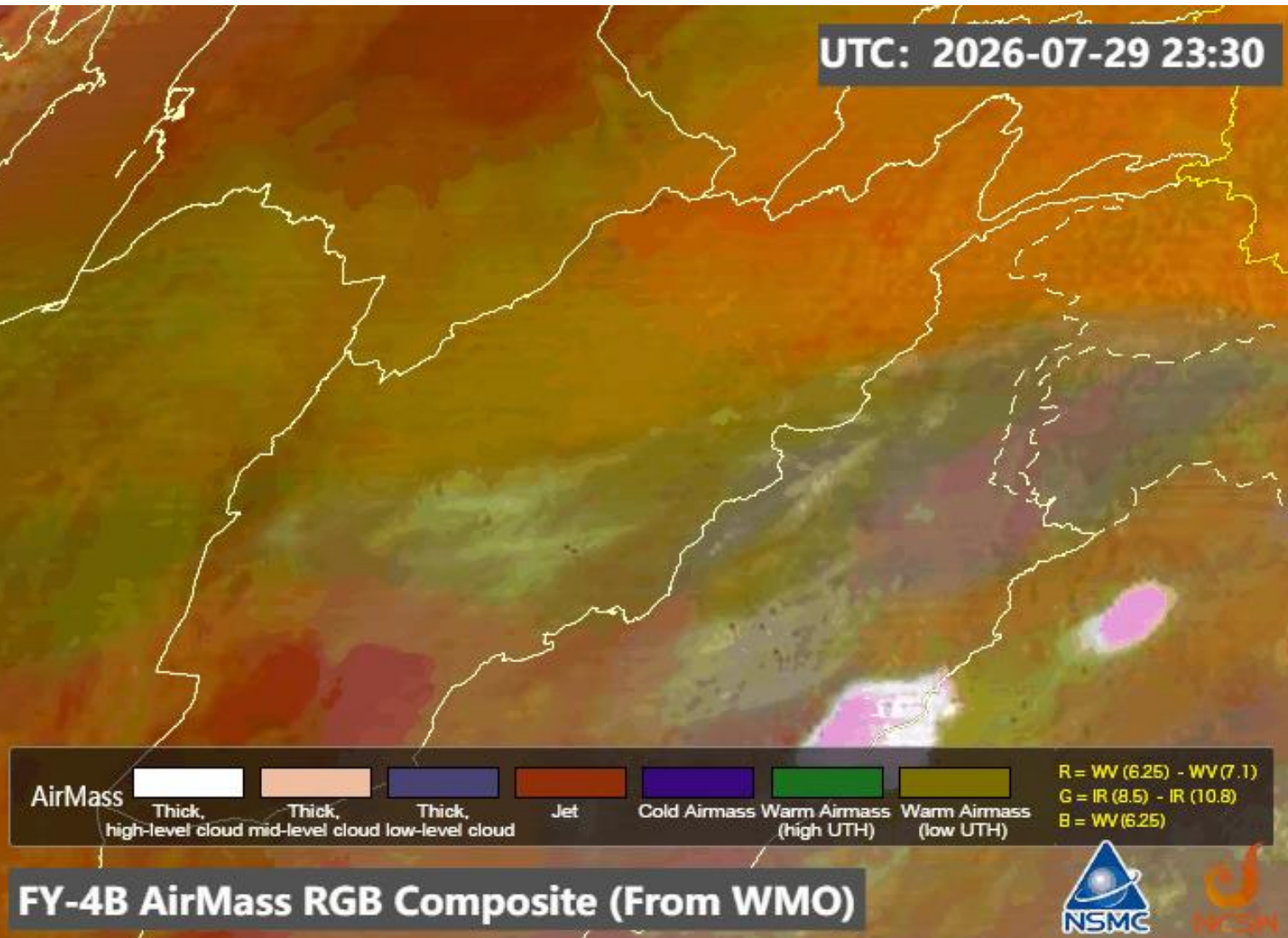

The southern, western, southeastern, and southwestern areas have weak water vapor.

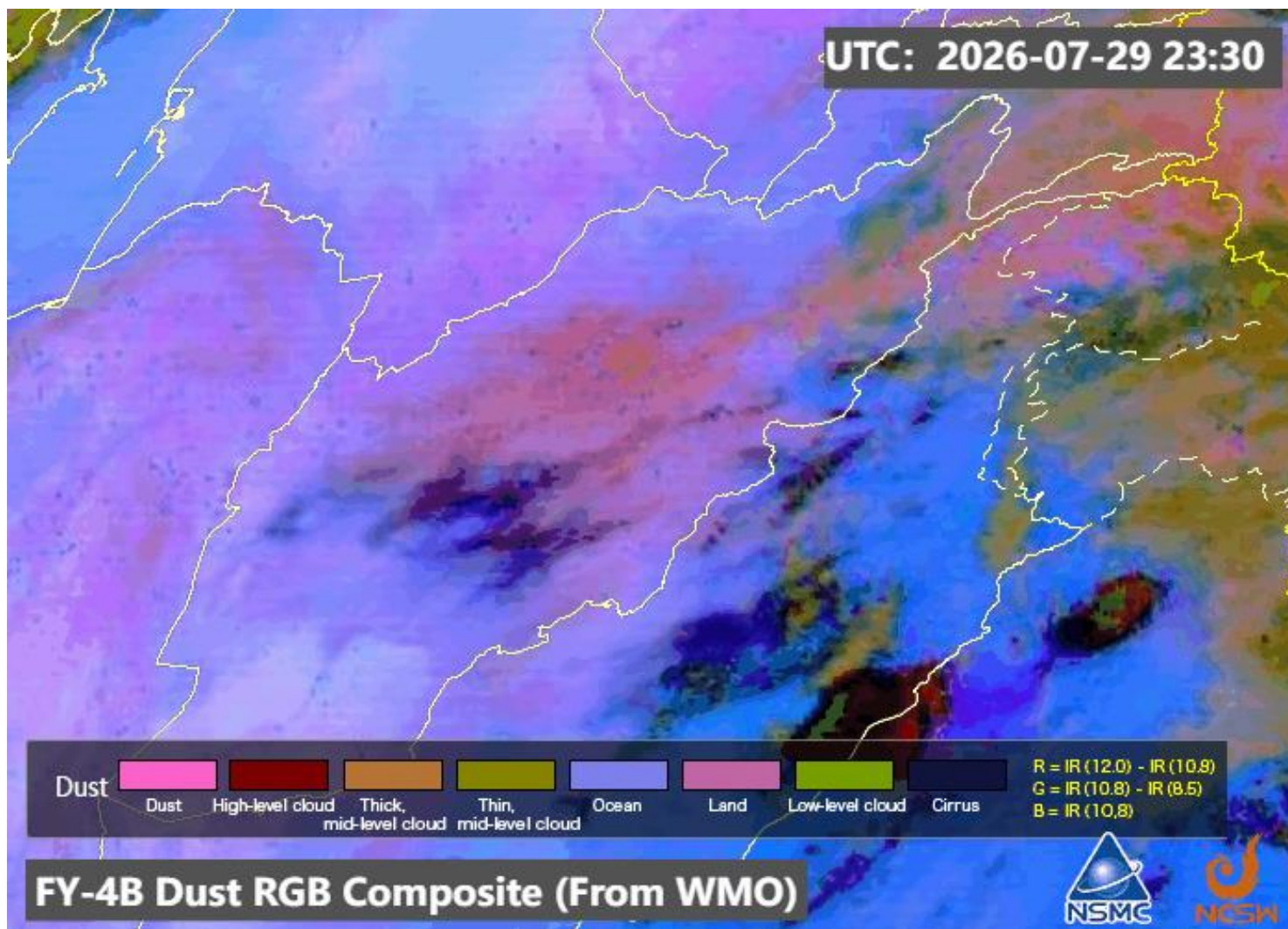

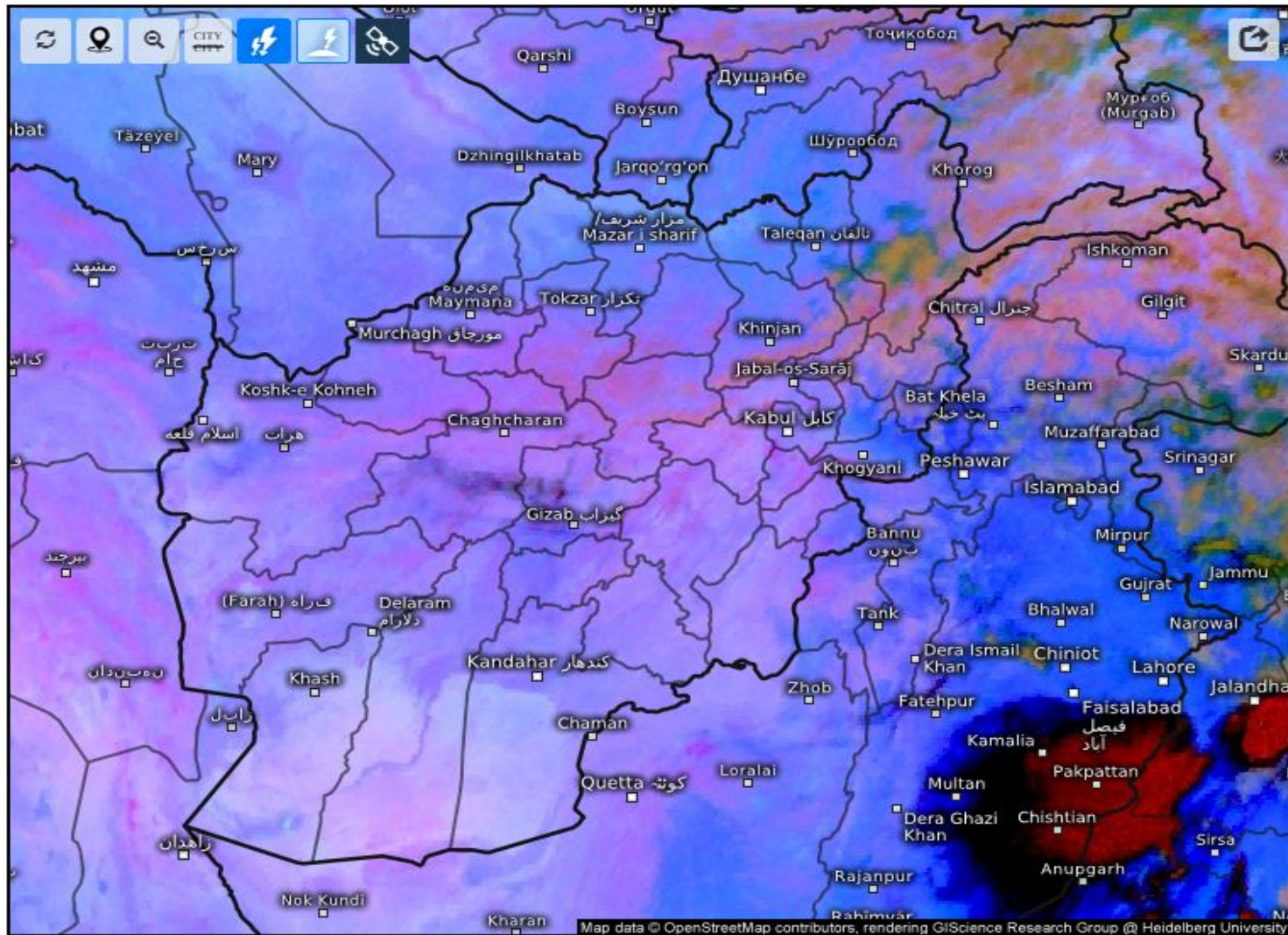

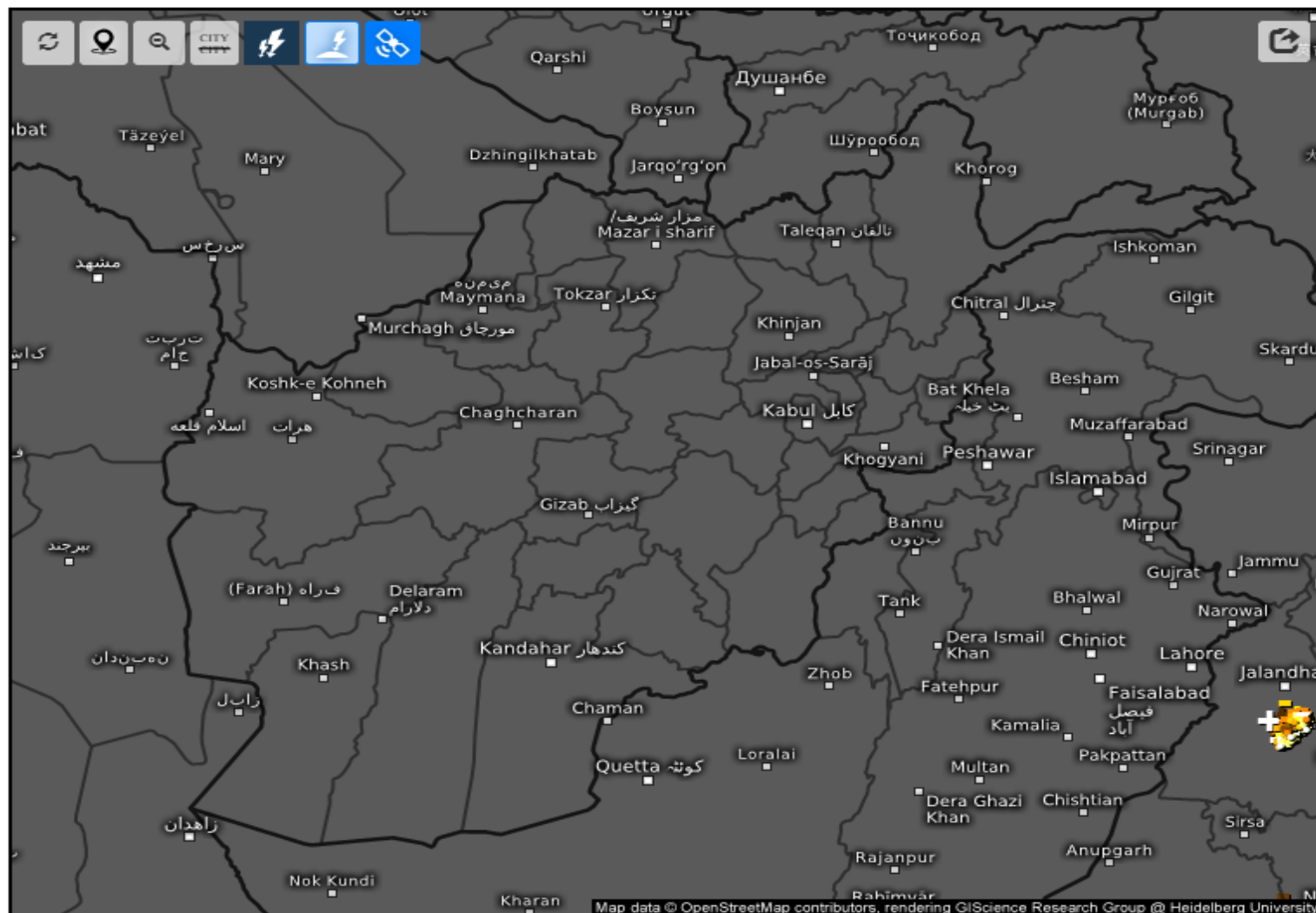

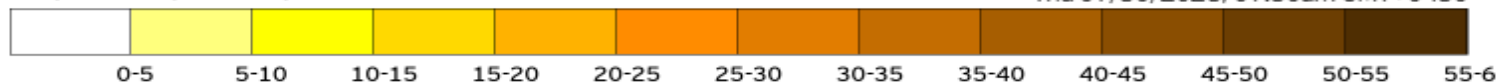
Satellite Dust

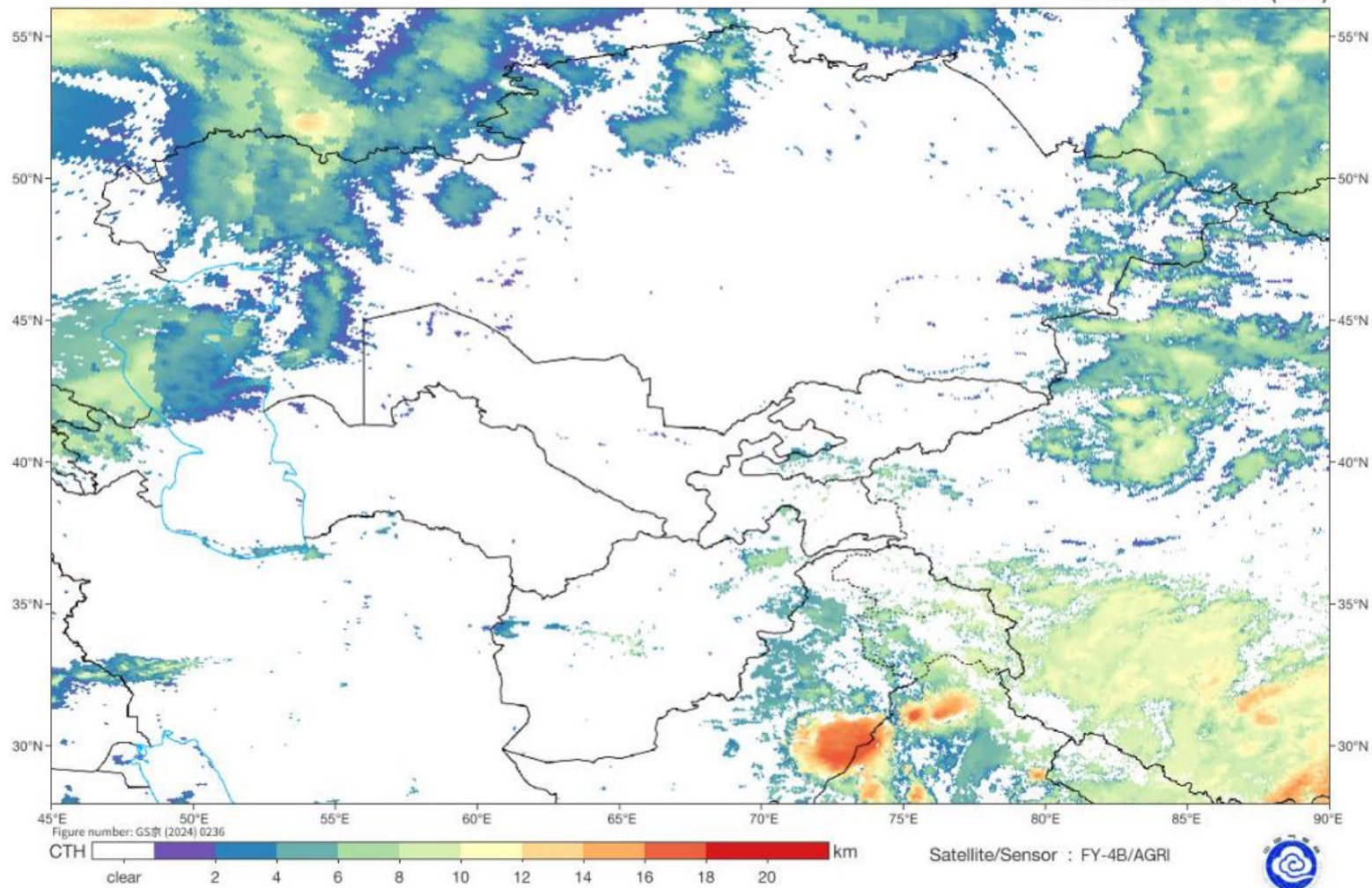
Age of lightning (minutes)

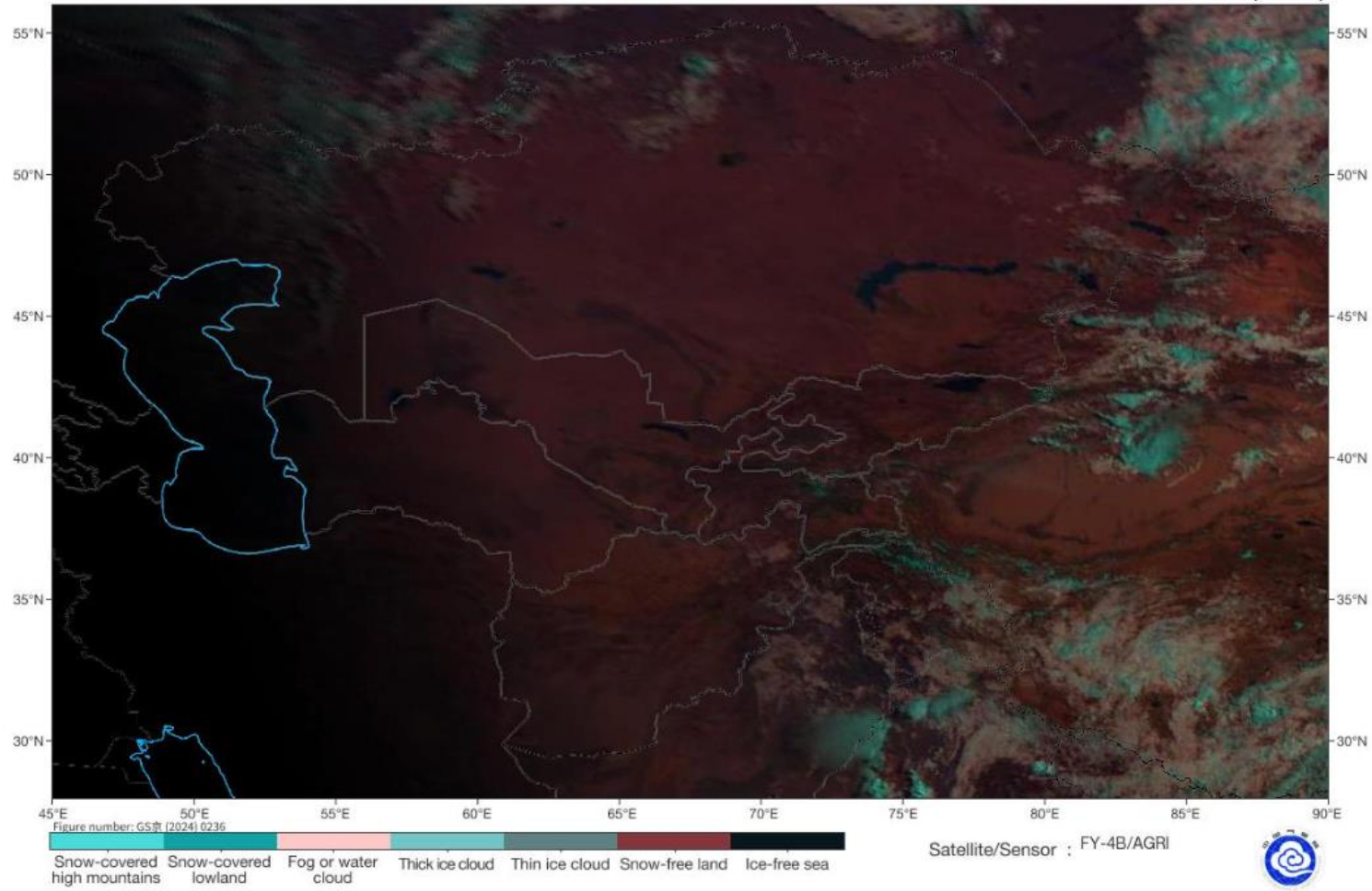


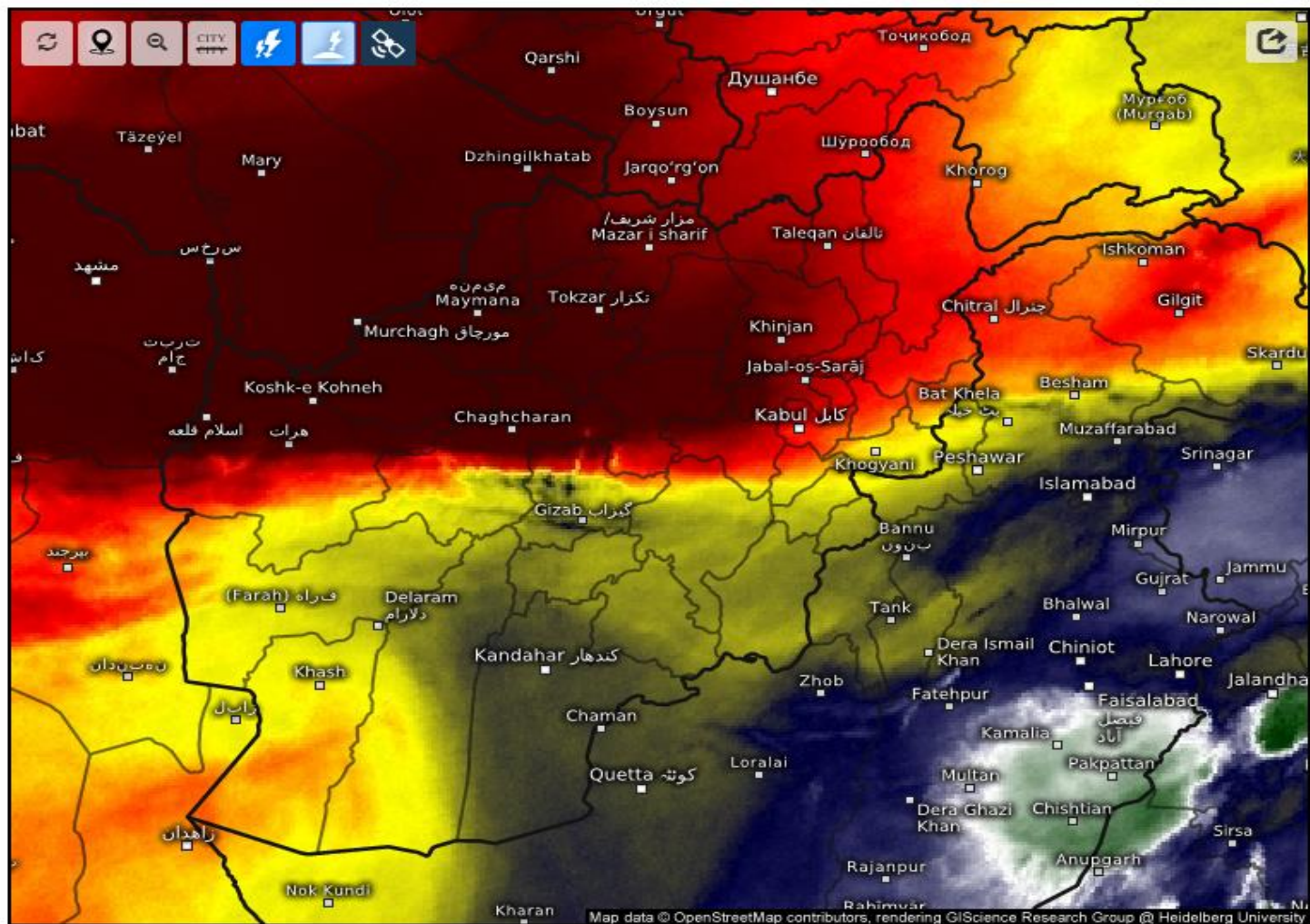
Live satellite map, Afghanistan

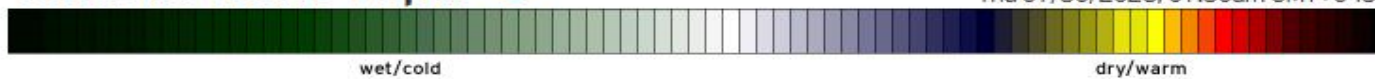
