The northern, southern, eastern, central, southeastern, northwestern, and southwestern areas are dry. The western, northeastern areas have weak water vapor.

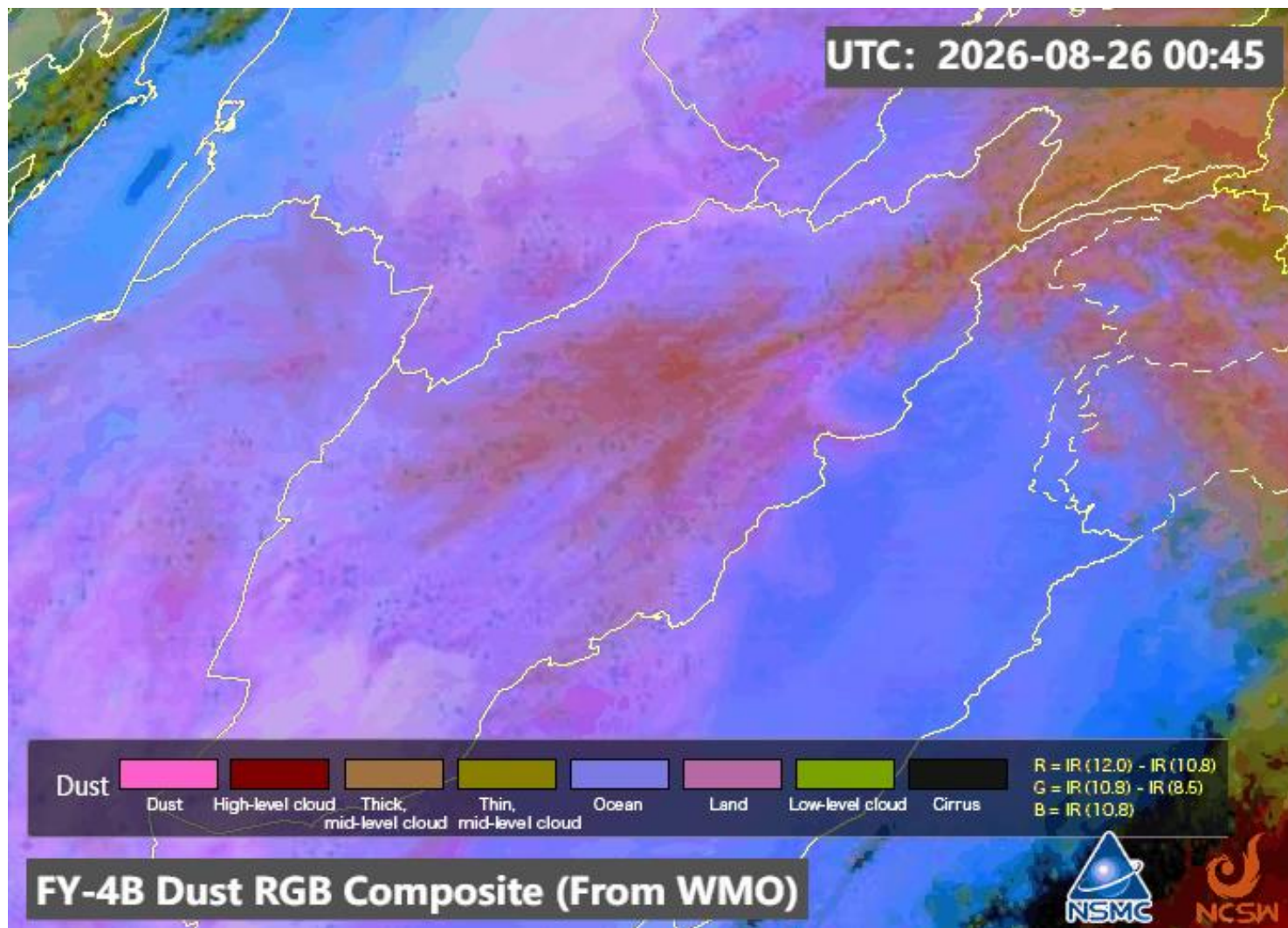

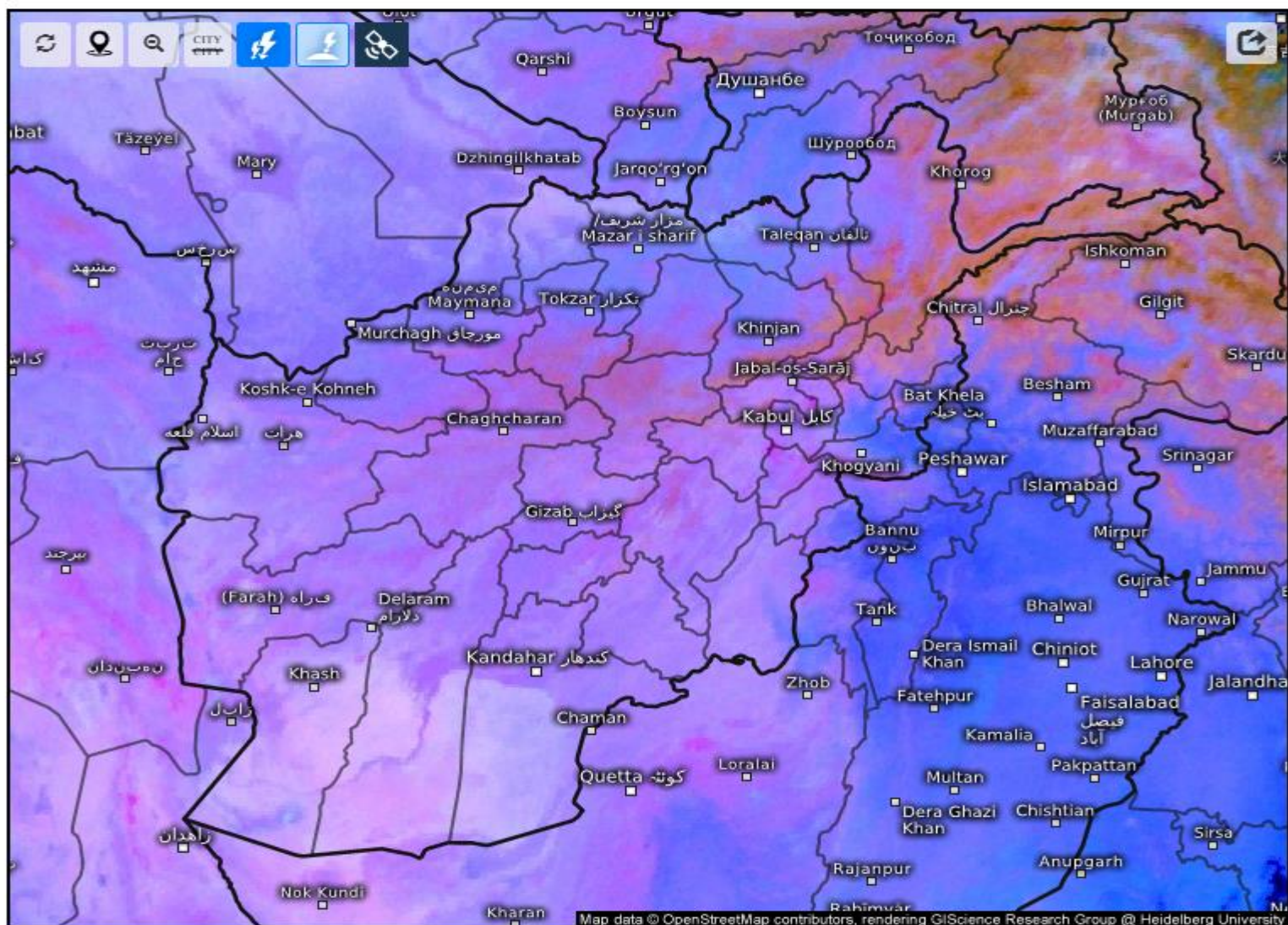


FY-4B AirMass RGB Composite (From WMO)



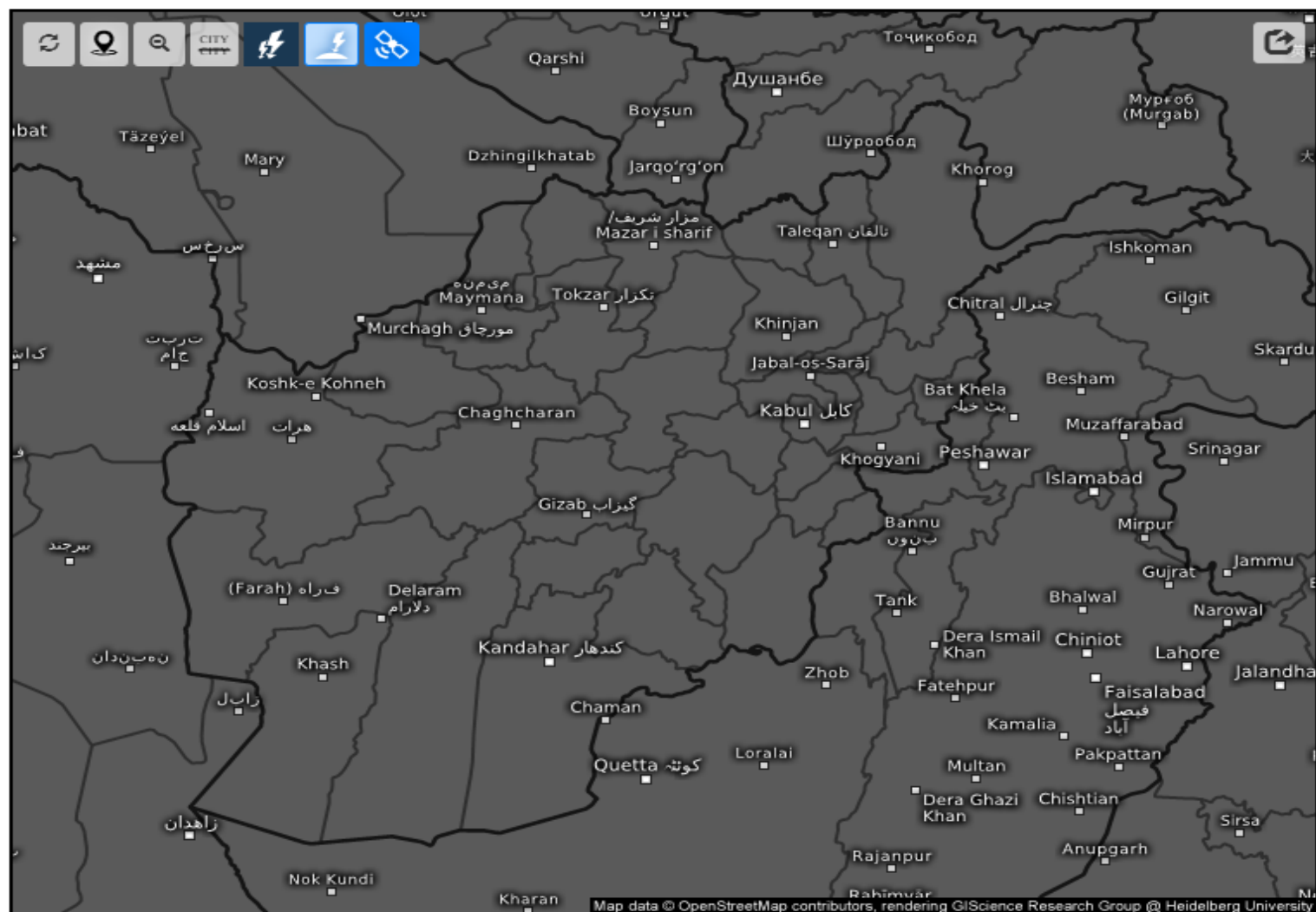

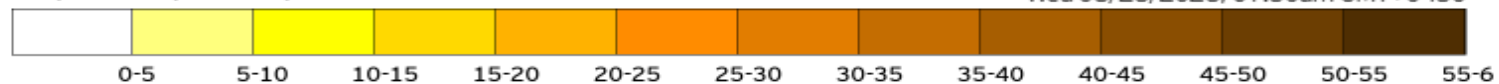
Satellite Dust

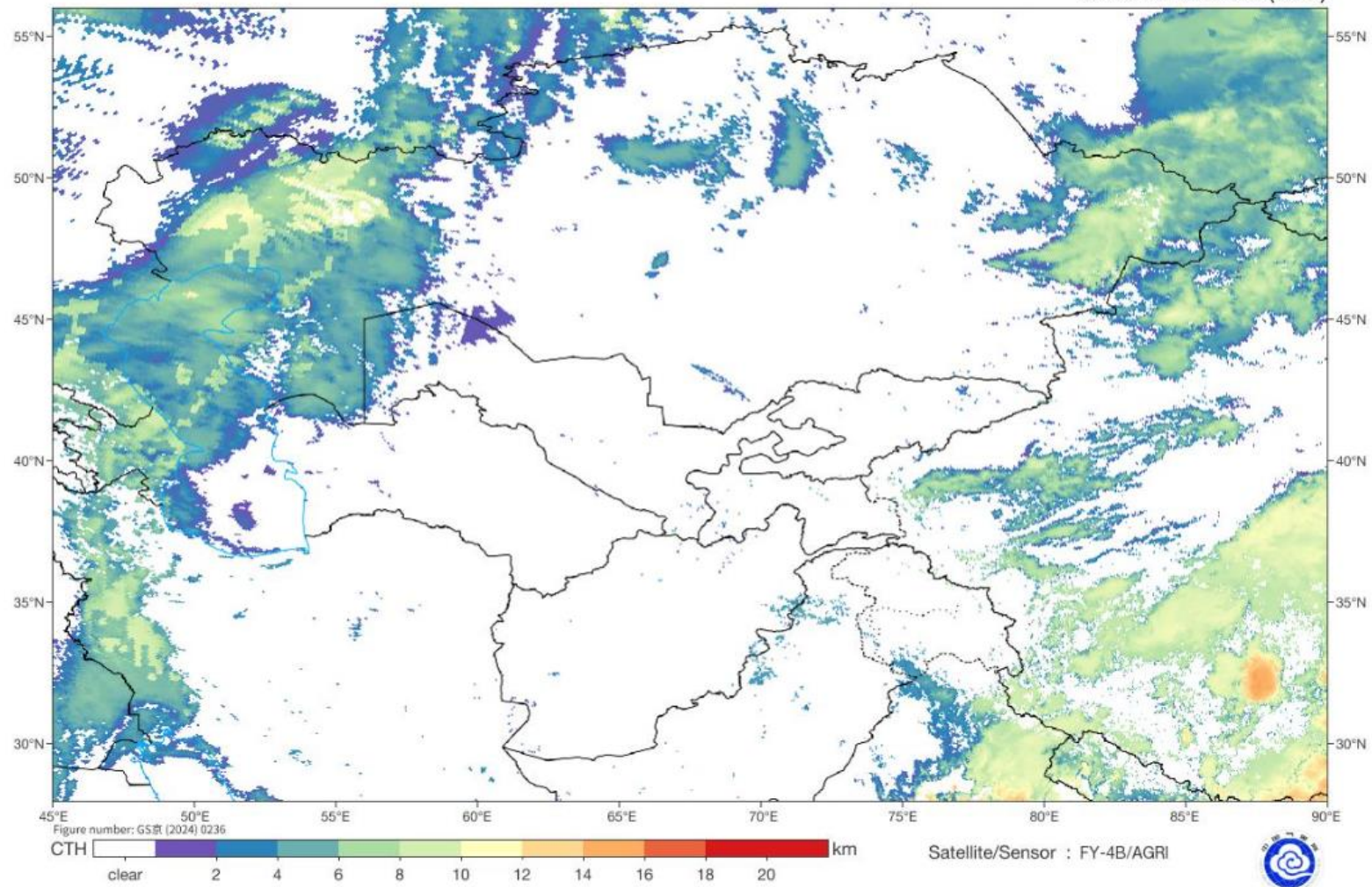
Age of lightning (minutes)

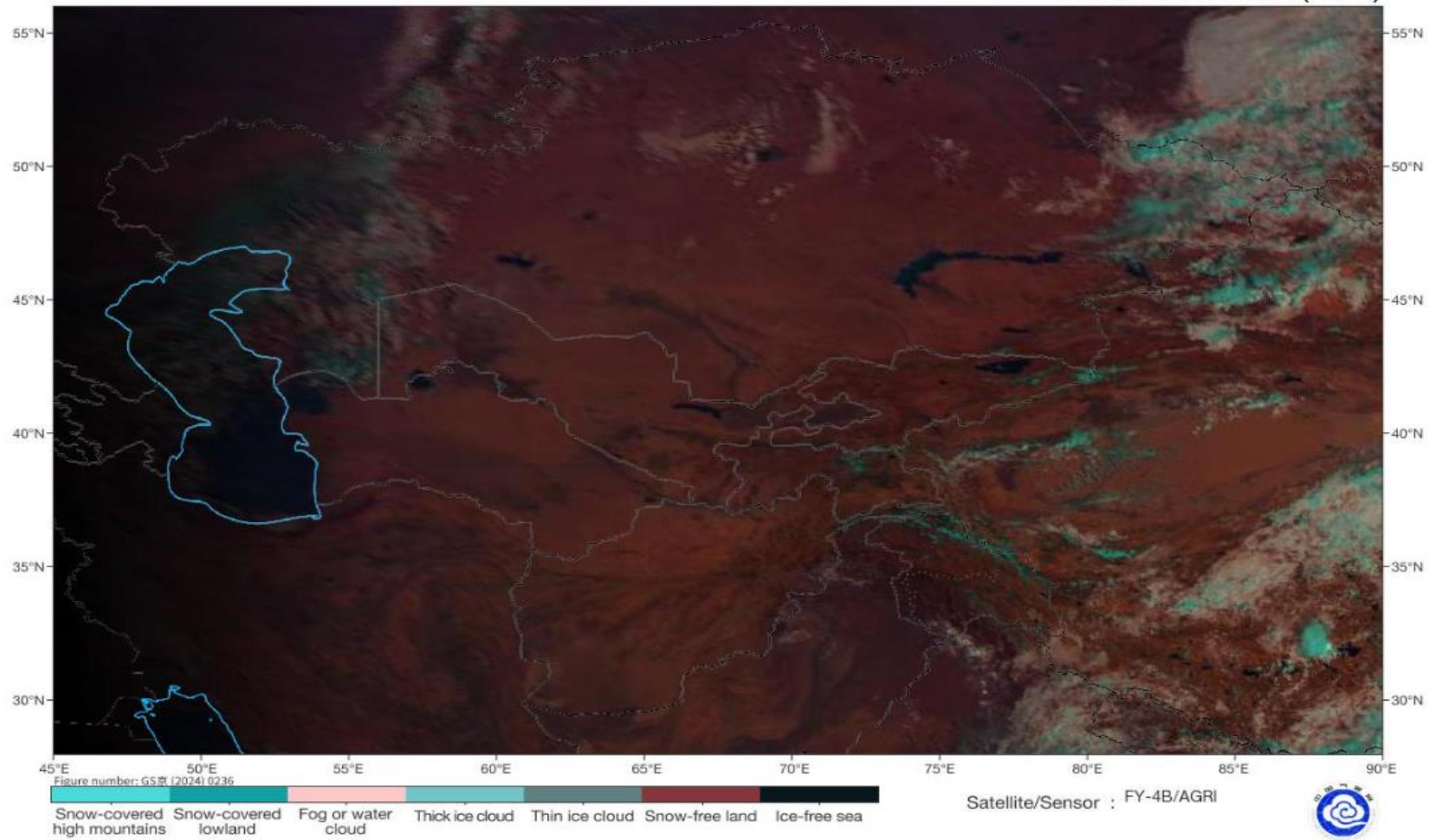


Live satellite map, Afghanistan



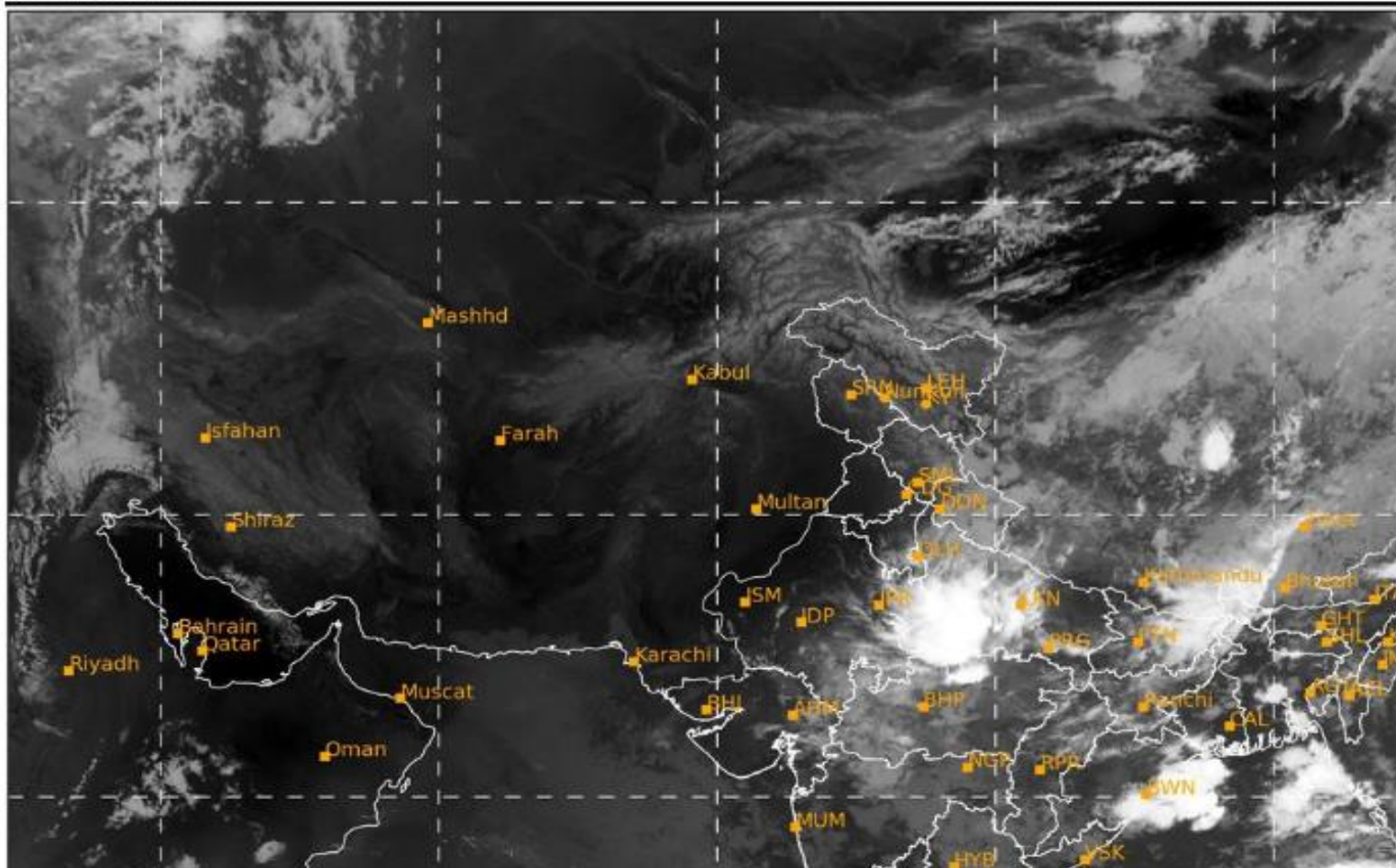

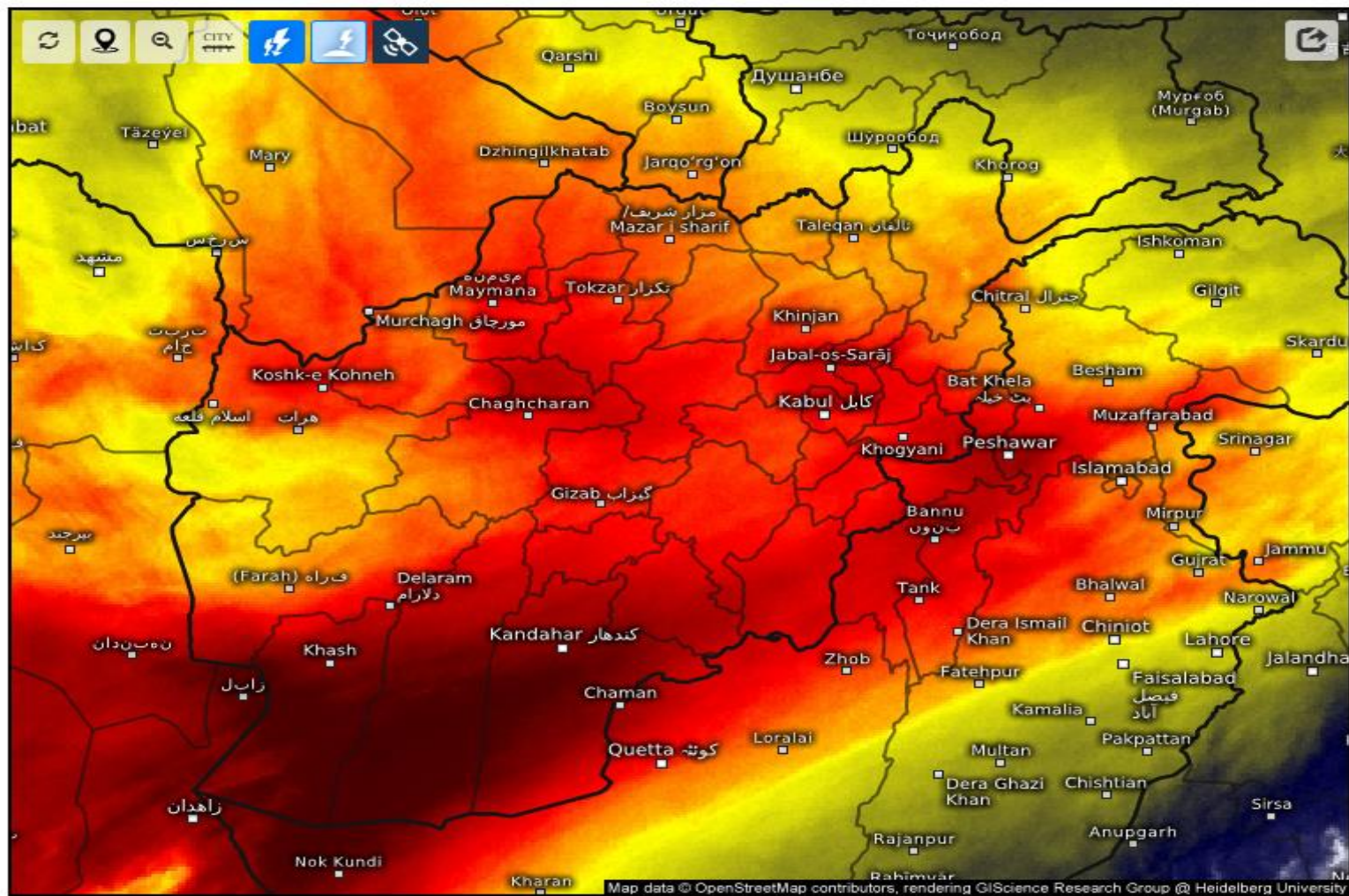

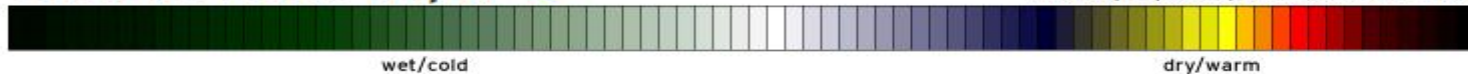

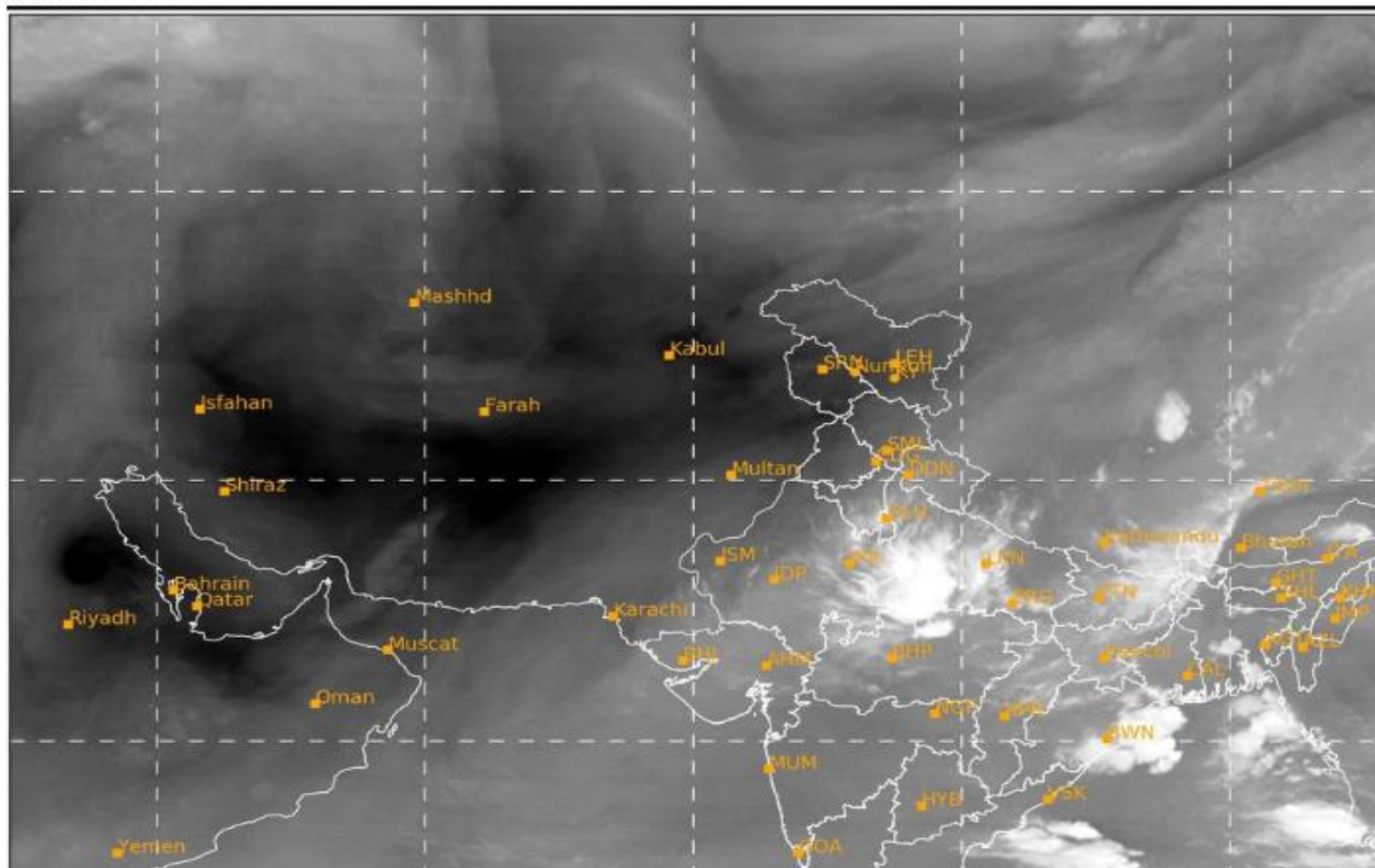
Satellite Water Vapor
